



## **Pinecrest Campground**

Pinecrest features a large campground by Pinecrest Lake, just 30 miles east of Sonora. The area includes a day-use beach and a marina, a small shopping center and recreation cabins. The campground caters to all ages and is within walking distance of the lake, an amphitheater, visitor center, swimming beach and spectacular hiking trails.

- Sites: 175 RV Sites · 200 Tent Sites · 200 No Hookup

- Directions: From Mi-Wuk, CA, take State Route 108 east 14.2 miles to "Y" intersection. Bear right and go 0.6 miles to campground sign. Turn right at sign into campground.



## **Pinecrest Campground**

Pinecrest Campground is situated in the Pinecrest Basin adjacent to the Pinecrest Lake Day Use Area. It has 200 campsites, each of which has a metal fire ring and a picnic table. Roads and parking areas, which vary in length, are paved. Water hydrants are located to serve several sites. All restrooms have flush toilets and sinks. All restrooms, except for 3 in "D" loop, have electricity for light and electrical appliances. Some restrooms are fully accessible. This campground is on a reservation system with the National Recreation Reservation Service (1-877-444-6777). It is essential that you

have a reservation if you intend to camp in Pinecrest between Memorial Day and Labor Day. Reservations can be made up to 6 months in advance. Plan early – this campground fills up fast in the summer months!

**Fees**--\$26.00 for a single-family site

The Interagency Senior and Interagency Access Passes are honored and provide a 50 percent discount on camping fees in the campground. Pass number must be written on fee envelope or Pass must be shown to Host. The Interagency Annual and Volunteer passes do not provide any discounts on camping. Dodge Ridge Corporation operates this campground under a special-use permit administered by the U.S. Forest Service. The fees collected from overnight campers go back into upgrading campground facilities and amenities.

**Permit Info:**

If you wish to use a stove, grill, or have a campfire it is recommended, but not required, that you get a campfire permit. This FREE Permit can be obtained at [preventwildfiresca.org](http://preventwildfiresca.org) or at any ranger station. Do not burn plastic or metal. Please leave the area in as good (or better) condition than you found it.

**Restrictions:**

Camp in designated sites only. The number of people allowed in a single campsite is six. The maximum length of stay in any campground is 14 days. Please leave the area in as good (or better) condition than you found it. Often, locations destroyed by thoughtless campers must be closed to restore the area's natural health. Help ensure your favorite area remains open.  
Maximum Length RV/Trailer: 40ft

**Water:**

Potable water is available at faucets throughout campground. Filling of RVs is prohibited.

**Restroom:**

Several flush toilets are located throughout the campground. No RV dump station available.

**Pinecrest Campground - 2017 Season**

**Pinecrest Campground is located within easy walking distance of Pinecrest Lake with its beach, marina, and fishing dock. Typical Pinecrest Campground campsite facilities include a paved parking pad, picnic table and fire ring. The majority of the sites are forested. Bathrooms have flush toilets, sinks and a utility sink. No RV hookups area available. There is a dump station available and water supply. The campground has water faucets with potable water. Wi-Fi internet service is available, during posted hours, within 100' of the kiosk. Pinecrest has a store, restaurant, weekly outdoor movies, Sunday church services, and ranger programs**

## Meadowview Campground



**Meadowview Campground** is located about a mile from **Pinecrest Lake** on Dodge Ridge Road. with its beach, marina, and fishing dock. A paved walking/bicycle path connects **Meadowview Campground** with **Pinecrest Campground** and **Pinecrest Lake**. **Meadowview Campground** campsites have paved parking pads, picnic tables and fire rings. The campsites are scattered through forested area. Bathrooms have flush toilets, sinks and a utility sink. No RV hookups area available. There is a dump station available and water supply. The campground has water faucets with potable water. In nearby **Pinecrest** you will find a store, restaurant, post office, weekly outdoor movies, Sunday church services, and ranger programs. At **Pinecrest Lake** are a designated swimming area and beach, fishing dock, and marina with boat rentals.

## **Pioneer Trail Group Campground**



**Pioneer Trail Group Campground is located about a half mile from Pinecrest Lake by dirt trail and two miles by road. Pioneer Trail Group Campground is perfect for groups from 50 to 100 people.**

**Pioneer Trail Group Campground** is divided into three shaded group areas. Each site features a large fire pit, picnic tables and vault toilets. Campsites 1 and 3 will accommodate up to 50 campers. Site 2 will accommodate up to 100 campers. Each site can accommodate 10 - 20 vehicles. No hook-ups or electricity available. Campground reservations are required during the summer months.

Nearby **Pinecrest** has a store, restaurant, weekly outdoor movies, Sunday church services, and ranger programs. **Pinecrest Lake** has a beach, marina, and fishing dock.
