

CLSD Livestock Freezer Sale Rules and Regulations

Deadline to sign up for or removal from Freezer Sale--6:00 p.m. Thursday of show week
Freezer Sale-10:00 a.m., Saturday of show week

The primary purpose of the Livestock Freezer Sale is to facilitate the sale of those exhibitors whose market animal projects are not in the Youth Auction. These exhibitors invested time and effort in producing these projects. In the past there has not been a structured way to sell the animals that did not qualify for the Youth Auction. This has caused hardship on the exhibitor, parents, Cleveland Livestock Show and Dairy Committees and CLS&DD buyers. The Livestock Freezer Sale is not meant to distract from the Youth Auction, but should give buyers an opportunity to purchase quality animals for their freezers and support the youth.

Freezer Sale Rules

- ⊕ Each exhibitor can sell a maximum of two (2) items in either the Youth Auction, and/or the Livestock Freezer Sale.
- ⊕ Each exhibitor CAN sell a total of three (3) in the following combination: An exhibitor can sell two (2) items in the youth auction and one (1) in the freezer sale.
- ⊕ A three percent (3%) Sales commission will be charged on all entries sold at the auction.
- ⊕ The maximum price for all projects in the Freezer Sale will be set as follows: Commercial Heifers, Market Broilers, Market Goats, Market Lambs, Market Rabbit, Market Steer and Market Swine - \$100.00 under the lowest selling animal in respective divisions in Youth Auction.
- ⊕ Procedure To participate/with drawl from Freezer Sale:
 - a. Exhibitors that do not have two projects in the Youth Auction and want to sell their projects in the Freezer Sale must notify the Livestock Secretary no later than 6:00 p.m. on Thursday of show week.
 - b. Exhibitor must fill out the required form to be eligible to participate in the Freezer Sale (form available in the Livestock office).
 - c. All requests to have an animal(s) removed from the Freezer Sale must be submitted in writing – NO VERBAL REQUEST will be accepted.
 - d. No request will be accepted after 6:00 p.m. Thursday of Show week.
- ⊕ Any re-sale animal funds must go to charitable or non-profitable organizations or the scholarship fund.

Pre-Freezer Sale

- ⊕ Buyers will have the opportunity to purchase Freezer Sale items for the maximum at the conclusion of the Youth Auction until one (1) hour before the Freezer Sale.
- ⊕ Exhibitors selling in the pre-freezer sale do not have to attend the Freezer sale on Saturday,
- ⊕ It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check with the Freezer Sale's committee to see if their animal has sold.

Sale of Animal

- ⊕ All sales of animals will be final and there will be no with drawls.
- ⊕ The exhibitor must deliver their animal as per the buyer's instructions.

Freezer Sale on Saturday

- ⊕ Exhibitors must meet under pavilion by 9:00 a.m. to be assigned a number Freezer sale auction will be held in the swine arena.
- ⊕ Exhibitors are not required to be present at the Freezer Sale if their project has been pre-sold or if there is a conflict.
- ⊕ If a conflict is unavoidable an eligible sibling or friend may substitute in the Freezer Sale. Those missing their place in the Freezer Sale order will be moved to the end.
- ⊕ Exhibitors are not guaranteed their project will sell, so they should plan to have a representative at the Freezer Sale on Saturday to assure that their minimum price is met.
- ⊕ All exhibitors participating in the freezer sale must complete a Thank You note. One for each buyer.
