

## CLS Breeding Beef Division Rules & Regulations

1. This division is subject to the CLS General Rules & Regulations and these Division Rules & Regulations.
2. All exhibitors must abide by all rules and regulations to be eligible to show.
3. All breeding beef entries must check-in during the times specified on the Schedule of Events.
4. At the specified time of check-in, the committee will inspect original registration papers or proof of birth date for unregistered animals. IF ANIMALS ENTERED IN THIS DIVISION DO NOT HAVE REGISTRATION PAPERS, THEY MUST BE SHOWN IN THE NON-REGISTERED OR CROSS BREEDS DIVISIONS. Copies of registration papers must be submitted with entry forms prior.
5. The Breeding Beef Committee for the breeding beef show will determine the breed divisions. Registered or crossbreed animals may be entered in the Breeding Beef Division. The Breeding Beef Committee will determine breed classes according to the entries. 5 head will constitute a breed.
6. Commercial Heifers may be doubled entered and show in the Breeding Beef Show, if they have the permission of the buyer who purchased the heifer before the Breeding Beef Show. Entry fees are non-refundable.
7. All animals must be halter broken.
8. All animals will be judged in the show ring and must be exhibited by the owner (unless owner has two calves in one class or selecting breed champion, or Committee chairperson grants permission).
9. No "For Sale" signs for animals will be permitted in the barn.
10. No guaranteed stalls for Out of County Breeding Beef exhibitors.
11. Classes will be judged as listed below:

American Breeds include: Beefmaster, Braham, Brangus, Santa Gertudis, Simbrah, ARB, Non-Registered

English Breeds include: Angus, Hereford, Red Angus, Shorthorn, English ORB, Non-Registered

Exotic Breeds include: Chianina, Charolais, Limousin, Main-Anjou, Simmental, Exotic ORB, Non-Registered

## **BREEDING BEEF CATTLE SHOWMANSHIP CONTEST**

1. This contest is open to all exhibitors in the Breeding Beef Division.
2. 4-H and FFA member competing in this contest must have an animal entered in the division and must own animals shown in showmanship contest.
3. The showmanship contest will be conducted after the Breeding Beef Cattle Judging. There will be two age groups: Seniors- exhibitors 14 years of age and older, and Junior exhibitors ages 13 and under. Contestants will be grouped according to their age on the date of judging.
4. Grand in each division will receive a buckle, Reserve will receive a Concho.

***Breeding Beef Entries must be post marked or turned in by April 1, 2022. The cost is 30.00 per head.***
