

CLS Breeding Rabbits Rules and Regulations

1. This division is subject to the General Rules and Regulations and these Division rules.
2. All entries must be made by **the** time specified on Important Dates & Deadlines accompanied by the correct entry fee and signed by the appropriate County Extension Agent or Vo-Ag teacher. (See General Rules for late and incomplete entries.) Entry fees are:
 - a. **Breeding Rabbits:** see schedule of events for entry deadlines. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
3. ARBA rules will govern the judging. Local show rules will supersede ARBA rules. The judge's decision will be final.
4. NO ONE is allowed behind the judging table except the Rabbit Committee. Please do not lean, prop, or otherwise hang on the judging table.
5. All rabbits entered in this division must be the bonafide property of the exhibitor.
6. ALL RABBITS MUST BE PERMANENTLY TATTOOED IN THE LEFT EAR PRIOR TO THE SHOW. EAR TATTOO NUMBERS MUST BE LEGIBLE AND MATCH THOSE LISTED ON THE ORIGINAL RABBIT ENTRY FORM OR THE RABBIT WILL BE SIFTED.

(PERMANENT MARKER DOES NOT CONSTITUTE BEING PERMANENTLY TATTOOED!)

7. Any rabbit showing signs of illness will be sifted and not allowed on the judging table. Animals sifted for reasons of illness need to be removed from the judging area immediately.
8. Each Exhibitor or pre-approved substitute must be present for judging and be able to place their rabbits on the table. NO adults will be allowed to place rabbits on the judging table – this is a YOUTH SHOW.
9. There will be no cash awards presented.
10. Only breeds found in the ARBA Standard of Perfection may be shown. No crossbreeds.
11. In order for a breed to have its own class there must be 5 entries for the breed. If there are not 5 entries they will be shown, as AOB, with all other breeds without 5 entries.
12. If no breed has 5 entries all breeding rabbits will be shown as one class. There will be ribbons presented to the first 6 places. Best of Show and Reserve Best of Show will be selected. Awards will be presented to Best of Show and Reserve Best of Show winners.
13. If there are enough entries in multiple breeds to have multiple classes there will be ribbons presented to the first 6 places in each class. The Best of Breed and Reserve Best of Breed will be selected from each class. Then all the Best of Breeds will return for judging of Best of Show and Reserve Best of Show. Awards will be presented to Best of Show and Reserve Best of Show winners.
