

CLS Breeding Beef Division Rules & Regulations

1. This division is subject to the CLS General Rules & Regulations and these Division Rules & Regulations.
2. All exhibitors must abide by all rules and regulations to be eligible to show.
3. NO CLS ENTERED COMMERCIAL HEIFERS CAN EXHIBIT IN THE BREEDING BEEF SHOW.
4. All breeding beef entries must check in during the times specified on the Schedule of Events.
5. At the specified time of check-in, exhibitors will receive their show number, as papers have already been verified via email. IF FEMALES ENTERED IN THIS DIVISION DO NOT HAVE REGISTRATION PAPERS, THEY MUST BE SHOWN IN THE NON-REGISTERED OR CROSS-BREED DIVISIONS. Copies of registration papers must be submitted to clevelandlivestockshow@gmail.com by the posted deadline.
6. The Breeding Beef Committee for the breeding beef show will determine the breed divisions. Registered or crossbreed FEMALES may be entered into the Breeding Beef Division. Bulls MUST be REGISTERED in the showman's name. The Breeding Beef Committee will determine breed classes according to the entries. 5 head will constitute a breed.
7. Bulls 18+ months of age must have a nose ring and lead, may be temporary or permanent.
8. Bulls can NOT be left on the grounds overnight.
9. All animals must be halter-broke.
10. All animals will be judged in the show ring and must be exhibited by the owner (unless the owner has two calves in one class or selecting a breed champion, or the Committee chairperson grants permission).
11. No "For Sale" signs for animals will be permitted in the barn.
12. No guaranteed stalls for out-of-county Beef exhibitors.
13. Entries are to be done online.
14. Classes will be judged as listed below:

American Breeds include:

Beefmaster, Brahman, Brangus, Santa Gertrudis, Simbrah, ARB, Non-Registered

English Breeds include:

Angus, Hereford, Red Angus, Shorthorn, English ORB

Exotic Breeds include:

Chianina, Charolais, Limousin, Maine-Anjou, Simmental, Exotic ORB, Non-Registered

BREEDING BEEF SHOWMANSHIP CONTEST

1. This contest is open to all exhibitors in the Breeding Female Division. **NO BULLS IN THE SHOWMANSHIP CONTEST.**
2. 4-H and FFA members competing in this contest must have an animal entered in the division and must own animals shown in the showmanship contest.
3. There will be two age groups: Seniors - exhibitors 14 years of age and older, and Junior exhibitors ages 13 and under. Contestants will be grouped by age as of the date of judging. Showmanship will be held after the show.
4. Grand and Reserve in each division will receive a buckle.
