

# CLS Market Steer Division Rules & Regulations

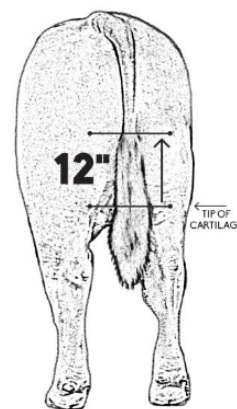
1. This division is subject to the CSL General Rules & Regulations and these Division Rules & Regulations.
2. All exhibitors must abide by all rules and regulations to be eligible to show.
3. Official tag-in and weigh-in will be at specified times on the Schedule of Important Dates and Deadlines at the CLS Show Grounds.

## A. Tag-In second Tuesday of November:

1. Market steers do not have a minimum or maximum weight at the November tag-in.
2. All market steers must have a halter on before walking into the chute at tag-in in November.
3. Market steers will be tagged in one ear and a hair sample will be pulled at tag-in.
4. If the animal loses the ear tag, the exhibitor must contact the market steer chairman immediately. The above immediately the mentioned person will get the tag replaced.

## B. Weigh-In at Show April:

1. Clipping: Prior to arrival at the Show, steers must be pre-clipped to no more than 1/4" of hair on any part of the body, except the tail switch, (the tail switch being no more than 12" above the end of the cartilage of the tail) which may be ratted and balled or may be bobbed off. Steers will be checked for hair length at the time of weigh-in. Steers found in violation of this rule will be eliminated and removed. The exhibitor will be eliminated from competition for the current show in the steer division. The 1/4" hair requirement is strictly enforced. Steers that leave the weigh-in area will not be re-evaluated for hair length. The decision made is final.
2. There is NO daily rate of gain, steers must weigh a minimum of 1000 pounds at the official weigh-in/check-in during show week. Steers not weighing the minimum 1000 pounds must be immediately loaded back on the trailer and leave CLS Showgrounds
3. Market Steers must weigh- in on scales at CSL Show Grounds and be tied in place at the time specified in the Schedule of Important Dates and Deadlines.
4. At weigh-in in April, steers will have one opportunity to go across the official scales, if the animal does not make the weight, it may be (at the exhibitor's request) backed off the scales; scales will be re-balanced, and the animal will be re-weighed immediately.
5. No weight tolerance will be allowed.
6. The steer must have a tag in both ears when returning to the show in April.
7. Market Steers will be shown with halter and proper showing paraphernalia is encouraged.



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8. This is a "blow and go only" show. Fitting with a foreign material that includes (but is not limited to All ethical techniques of proper grooming and fitting steers for the show will be too) painting, powdering, artificial coloring, artificial hair, fibers, or adhesives are prohibited.
9. Exhibitors must remove sweat collars from their steers when they weigh in.
10. Steers must be dehorned before weigh-in at the show.

### **C. Judging at Show April:**

1. Each exhibitor must be able to show his/her steer unassisted.
2. The classes will be determined after all Market Steers have been weighed.
  - a. Steers will be divided into 3 Classes:
    - i. Light Weight
    - ii. Medium Weight
    - iii. Heavy Weight
3. All steers will be brought back into the arena to select the Grand and Reserve Champion Steer. As well as for the purpose of selecting sale orders.
4. Exhibitors not present with their steer when the sale order is called will be scratched from the sale. 5. Amount of Steers Sold – See Premium Auction Rules.

### **D. Stomach pumping is not allowed.**
