

# CLSDD Market Lamb Division Rules & Regulations

1. This division is subject to the CSLDD General Rules & Regulations and these Division Rules & Regulations.
2. All exhibitors must abide by all rules and regulations to be eligible to show.
3. This division is open to wether or ewe lambs. Lambs must be wethered before official tag-in.
4. Market lamb must have ear tag in ear when it comes to CLSDD Show weigh-in. If the lamb loses tag, the exhibitor must immediately contact the Market lamb Committee Chairman. If the lamb loses ear tag and comes to CLSDD Show weigh in without Market Lamb Committee Chairman being notified, it will not be eligible to show.
5. The market lambs must not weigh less than 85 pounds at the weigh-in when it comes to show. Lambs will have one opportunity to go across the official scales (at weigh-in during show); if animal does not make the weight, it will be (at Exhibitor's request) backed off the scales, scales will be re-balanced, and animal will be re-weighed immediately. No weight tolerance will be allowed.
6. Market Lamb that are sifted due to not making weight limits will be required to load back up on the trailer and leave the premises immediately.
7. Under weight market lambs are not eligible for the freezer auction.
8. The lambs must be slick shorn (upward from the knee and hock) no more than 5 days before the weigh-in at show.
9. According to the State and Federal Scrapie Requirements: All ewes must have a Premise Identification ear tag Place before they come back to the show in April.
10. Each exhibitor must be able to show his or her lamb unassisted. No halters or lead rope will be allowed during judging or the showmanship contest.
11. All lambs must be carrying their milk teeth at the time of tag-in. Lambs showing either, or both, of the first pair of permanent incisors will not be allowed to enter.
12. All lambs will be shown in one class unless deemed necessary by Market Lamb Committee to divide into more than one class. If determined by the committee, classes will be divided with approximately the same number of animals in each class.
13. Fifty (50%) percent or ten (10), whichever is greater, of the number of animals weighed in at show time will be sold at the Premium Auction.
14. No paint, powder, or artificial color can be used on the market lambs.
15. Market lambs will be nose printed at the time of check-in when it comes to show.
16. Ewe lambs exhibiting signs of pregnancy at show will be disqualified. The show judge or the Market Lamb Committee may determine pregnancy.
17. Non-sale lambs will be released after judging and must be removed by time specified Schedule of Important Dates & Deadlines.
