Registration Fee: \$10 per class. No stallions are permitted; mules are permitted. Age of horse and exhibitors is determined by age as of Jan. 1, 2022. Jr: 12 and under; Sr: 13-19 (must not have graduated from a secondary school). A current negative Coggins must be presented at registration. Awards, including buckles and conchos, will be given in each class.

- 2) Halter Mares – 3 and over
- 3) Halter Geldings – 3 and over

- 6) Lead Line – ages 7 and under

Halter: The horse is judged based upon conformation and resemblance to the breed ideal.

Showmanship: The exhibitor is judged on their ability to execute a pattern in hand.

Horsemanship: Judged based on rider position and skill in executing a pattern. No rail work in these classes.

Ranch Horse Pleasure: Horses shall be shown as a group in each class at the walk, extended walk, trot, extended trot; lope and extended lope (class 10) in both directions. Riders will be asked to reverse, back and stop their horse.

ATTIRE: Exhibitors must wear long pants, long sleeve shirt with collar, western hat or ASTM certified riding helmet, and western boots.
