#### Paper Statements are changing:

Please be aware that the HOA will be changing to a coupon system for the monthly HOA payments beginning September 1st, 2018. This system will enable the HOA to save quite a bit on administrative costs. Those who already pay by ACH through the PMC office will not receive coupons. We encourage homeowners who are not already on ACH to sign up for your monthly HOA payment.

#### Parking, Parking, Parking:

We are all aware of the narrow streets that we have which are owned and maintained by our HOA. Due to our narrow streets, we must ensure constant access by any and all emergency vehicles. The Board has had numerous complaints about parking violations, and when we are made aware, property owners and renters are given a courtesy letter reminding them of our rules.

However parking on both sides of the street, due to their narrow construction, is hazardous anytime. If you have had to navigate your street through cars parked on each side, just think of the difficulty of a large fire truck or other emergency response vehicle trying to do so. Accordingly the Board decided to post parking signs at the entrance to each street, and on one side of the street stating "No overnight parking" and "No parking this side of street". The Board asks all owners and renters to be responsible for their guests. The Board will enforce these posted parking rules.
