# Highlights of the Quarter

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Landscape Contractor. On April 1, 2019 Woodridge will be served by Heritage Landscape Services, who will take over from long time provider Green Horizons. Heritage brings to us resources we desperately need to help us better control and manage our water use, Ryan Hoover, owner, is an Expert Certified Water Manager, at time of his certification one of only 9 in California. They provide innovative management tools and have a great reputation and high recommendations from current HOA's where they provide services. Water Use. Our POA last year used 10 million gallons of water with a \$100,000 price tag . That equates to 7353 gallons per home at \$735 cost per home. Reducing our usage is a high priority while not sacrificing the beauty of our landscape.

Savings! The replacement of our street lights with high efficiency, low maintenance LED lighting is nearly completed. This investment will "pay back" in roughly three years, providing us electricity cost savings and maintenance savings.
