

PUMPKINS & PANCAKES FUNDRAISER

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- 1. Does the 3 Ticket Limit include my student performer?** Yes, the 3 ticket limit INCLUDES the student performer & tickets must be for one seating until the 3 Ticket Limit ends. This means you may only buy 3 tickets total per student performer. Buy more than this & your tickets may be cancelled with NO REFUND. More tickets can be purchased starting on **Monday 10/20/25** & until sold out.
- 2. I have multiple student performers at each seating. May I purchase tickets for each seating?** Yes, but to purchase tickets for both seatings, you must do a separate transaction for each seating & only purchase 3 Tickets Total for each student performer until the 3 ticket limit ends. Buy more than this & your tickets may be cancelled with NO REFUND. More tickets can be purchased starting on **Monday 10/20/25** & until sold out.
- 3. When does the 3 Ticket Limit end?** On **Monday 10/20/25** you may purchase all the tickets you want until sold out & for BOTH Seatings if you wish. Separate transactions are required for each seating.
- 4. Why is there a 3 Ticket Limit?** With so many music students (about 400) and a seating capacity of about 500 per seating, we need to ensure that all music families have the opportunity to attend.
- 5. Is my music student required to attend Pumpkins & Pancakes?** Yes. This is a mandatory performance that is provided on the Band Calendar. However, he/she is NOT required to stay after their Showcase (which is PRIOR to the food service). Students who are **not** going to stay/join family inside for the remainder of the event will be escorted by a volunteer to the loop for pick up to go home.
- 6. Is our family or student required to purchase an admission ticket/wristband?** Students are required to perform during the Showcase, but may be picked up after they play their two songs. Anyone wanting admission to the event (whether planning to eat or not) **MUST** purchase an admission wristband for any/all seating he/she is attending. We have NO WAY to track who is/is not eating at the event, as it is served "Family Style."
- 7. Do I need to purchase an admission wristband for my music student?** You only need to purchase an admission wristband if your student is staying and/or joining you after they perform during their Showcase (two songs).
- 8. Can I watch the Showcase without purchasing an admission wristband?** No. Only people who have purchased an admission ticket, or signed up to volunteer for the seating may be in the gymnasium during the event.

- 9. What if I have a student in 6th Grade Band or Choir as well as 7th/8th Grade Band and I want to watch them BOTH perform?** Anyone at the event must have either an ADMISSION or VOLUNTEER wrist band. Therefore, you have two choices: 1) Purchase admission wristbands for BOTH event seatings for any/all family members attending; or 2) Purchase admission wristbands to ONE seating and sign up to VOLUNTEER at the other seating. - 10. How many songs do the students play for the Showcase?** They usually only play two songs.
- 11. Is my Orchestra student performing?** No, not this time.
- 12. How does my student or family member(s) sign up to volunteer for the event?** If you are interested in being an ADULT VOLUNTEER, use this Signup Genius link to sign up: [P&P Adult Volunteer Sign Up](#) and choose an available position for the corresponding seating time. - 13. Can my student volunteer during the SAME seating he/she is performing?** No.
- 14. Our family is unable to attend; however, my student is a 6th grader and wants to volunteer for the next seating. What should he/she do?** If they are volunteering later they have three options. 1. Go home and come back. 2. Wait outside with a book. 3. Purchase an admission wristband for your student for the 1st Seating, so he/she can stay after performing. Then he/she can check-in at the VOLUNTEER CHECK-IN table for the position he/she signed up in Signup Genius to do during the 2nd Seating.. We will not be providing supervision for them in between the breakfast and volunteering.
- 15. When will our admission wristbands and/or raffle tickets be available?** Wristbands will be distributed to students in class before the event, the week of P&P. Please be sure to arrive to the event wearing your wristband. Raffle tickets will be sold at the event only, so be sure to arrive early!
- 16. Will admission wristbands be available for purchase at the door the day of the event?** This varies from year to year. It depends on if we have reached capacity for the event. If there are any available, please arrive by 7:30am to purchase since we may sell out before the 2nd Seating.
- 17. What forms of payment do you accept for raffle tickets at the event?** Cash and credit cards only. NO CHECKS please.
