# **Benicia Yacht Club and Cub Scout Pack 108 Support Coastal Cleanup on September 19**

We had four very hard-working people from the Benicia Yacht Club participate in Coastal Cleanup Month 2020 on September 19—three pickers and one person directing traffic. We worked the marina, the tidal area south of the marina between the 5th street dock and the marina entrance, and the marina green. We were fortunate to have a very low tide so we were able to work the shoreline and retrieved debris that normally could not be reached. We collected a lot of plastics—food containers, bottles, plant containers and toys— along with the expected trash items. Between the three of us, we collected 8 bags in about 2-1/2 hours and as the picture shows, also a tire and wheel. My best guess is that we had 100+ pounds between us, although when I completed the CleanSwell app for BYC the estimate came out less.

And as you saw when you came by on Saturday, we were joined at noon by the equally hard-working (evidenced by dirty tennis shoes and rubber boots) Cub Scout Pack 108—17 eager scouts and scout leaders. Hopefully they reported their result to the app but they did say they had worked the end of First Street and had collected one whole bag of cigarette butts. They also collected a goodly number of salt and pepper packets, presumably from the local restaurants in that area.




Bob has been a member of BYC for 5-1/2 years. He likes the people, the food and especially the live music at the Club.
