

# FROM THE HELM



In my last few "From the Helm" articles I have mentioned volunteers frequently. As membership chair Kathy Monroe points out to new members, our Club—even though we have staff—is run by volunteer power.

Due to the Covid-19 virus, in March of 2020 we had to close and were forced to cut back from a staff of 15 down to 1. We reopened in June and brought back Carlos, Jeannie and Mya to join Andy Ahn. Even though we were severely limited by regulations in the service we could provide, we often found ourselves short-handed. **Volunteers picked up the slack big time.** Mark Connors was our dishwasher. Angela Grigas took reservations, was often the busser server and whatever else needed to be done. Pat Bowers managed the Club. Anything that needed to be fixed was fixed by a growing crew of house volunteers backing up Randy Norman and Richard Boltz.

By October 2020 we had dropped from more than 200 memberships pre-pandemic down to 158. I am happy to report that thanks to folks doing a lot of hard work, **we are now up to 214 memberships** (and most memberships include 2 people). As I write this Kathy is signing up our 400th active member. We are now up to 9 employees and are actively working to recruit more.

Our **food service** is now upstairs *and* downstairs and we are renting out the facility again. With the mask mandate going away in mid-February, people are coming back to the Club more regularly so we can be open more hours. And with the weather getting better and the sailing season getting into full swing, Club use should keep growing.

All this gets me back to volunteers. The Board and our committee chairs, listed on page 2, make up more than 20 dedicated volunteers. I thought that maybe I should list others, but I realized that it would amount to a total of 48 or more. **Thanks to all who help! Those who volunteer get something out of it, too:**

# Winter "Frostbite" Series




