#### **November 2021 BYC Facility Renovation Update**

Project planning and development continues and work has begun

#### **Finance**

We continue to work with our financial partners to put together our financial information in a form satisfactory to lenders. We now have Steven Green, CPA under contract preparing the financial information needed.

#### **Architect**

We have selected an architectural firm to help us with the HVAC project. George Corrigan with ANI will be our contact. A site visit was completed and designs for our HVAC project plus base designs are underway.

#### **Interim Projects**

Some work continues in the planning process or outside of the major project.

Filler that Brian West had from another project was placed in the parking lot. The ground consumed a lot of the material. The project will be expanded next Spring.

There has been lots of discussion on siding. After reviewing the temporary paint option for the north wall, it was decided not to go ahead with peel stop because the siding material in the worst areas just needs to be replaced. A solicitation for siding donations went out but so far has been unsuccessful.

We got pricing on luxury vinyl planking to replace flooring upstairs and down. The pricing seemed reasonable and indicates a working strategy. The kitchen flooring will need to be separate due to code issues. Interior painting will probably precede flooring in project sequence. These items will likely follow financing, but can be done during the rainy season, so may end up being some of the earlier projects to be completed.

The awning on the Regatta Room deck was upgraded; we may also add clear vinyl windows.

Our plumber is now under contract to replace our leaking water service. The company is obtaining permits at this time.

As noted above, the Architect is under contract for the heating and cooling project designs are being prepared. Funds for both the water connection and the HVAC project are already in place outside of the larger project.


## **2022 Cruise-Out Schedule as of 10/28/21**
