

### \*\*Jazz Cup 2024: A Nautical Tale of Triumph and Teamwork\*\*

The Jazz Cup 2024 was a thrilling race, one that saw us crossing the finish line faster than most, with an impressive elapsed time of under three hours. Our weekend adventure began on Friday afternoon as we sailed the *E Ticket* from Benicia to Richmond Yacht Club. The evening wind, though light, created a relaxing and picturesque journey across the water.

Race day dawned with a forecast of gentle winds, prompting the Race Committee to shorten the course, moving the start line to the vicinity of Red Rock Island. We were in the fifth starting fleet, among 11 highly competitive boats. Our start time was set for 11:25am, with the Port side of the course showing the most promise—a side we strategically chose. The strong flood current played its part, causing most starters to lag behind. However, we managed an exceptional start, leading our fleet off the line.

As we sailed towards the weather mark, we briefly lost a few positions, rounding it in third place. But as we approached the Brothers Islands, we chose to hug the Northwest side of the course, hoping to catch more of the current near the channel. The gamble paid off, and we surged into the lead. Then rounding Point Pinole, two boats cut the corner on us, taking advantage of a more favorable current and wind, slipping past us.

Approaching the Carquinez Strait, we observed that the South side near the C&H Sugar Factory had lighter winds. We passed under the Carquinez Bridge on the North side. Our two lead competitors went South, giving us the opening we needed to regain our lead. We focused on staying clear of wind holes, navigating through streams of favorable flood current. In the end, we crossed the finish line first in our fleet! We were third place in the overall Jazz Cup competition.

As we docked and began putting the boat away, the live music from BYC drifted across the marina, providing a fitting soundtrack to our day. Arriving in Benicia, we were welcomed by friendly faces on the shore and many friends who came down to our berth to hear our tales of the race.

Though we didn't claim the overall Jazz Cup victory, we reveled in the fierce competition, the splendid weather, and the camaraderie of the day. Congratulations to other strong Benicia Racer performances. Reuben Rocci on *Swiftness* placed second for Jazz Cup and David Stellato on *Living Happy* placed first in their division.

The crew of *E Ticket* and the community that supports us are nothing short of extraordinary. This event requires immense effort, from preparation to transportation, provisioning, and, of course, racing. Our crew's dedication and skill are unparalleled—without them, we wouldn't be nearly as competitive, nor would we have as much fun.


