End of Season Updates for Nautica Group Activities

On Saturday, September 20, BYC again joined with the City of Benicia to participate in Coastal Cleanup Day. Nine BYC members fanned out from our parking lot station to work the marina, the shoreline at the green, and also the shoreline east of Fifth Street. In total we collected and delivered 56 pounds of debris to the city's main drop-off station at Ninth Street Park. If you know Sharon Denney, please thank her for including BYC in coordinating the city's efforts.

We were also visited by our friends at the US Coast Guard Auxiliary to present Benicia Yacht Club with a Certification of Appreciation for working with them in allowing their use of the Regatta Room for their presentations on water safety and boater training classes.

We joined with the Allegory Project team last month, meeting with Benicia's Director of Library and Cultural Service Jennifer Baker. The project's premise is *The Sailboat as Art: A Celebration of Benicia's History*. The agreement between the Allegory Project and the city calls for the art project's completion by the end of the year, although the monies for the project did not come through until September. Jose Luis Varta, the pro-



ject's artist, requested—an extension into next year. Jennifer and her team needed hard dates so they could go back to the city and provide an accounting on the project, and get the approval. We (BYC) set dates for Nautica Group meetings for January 18 and—February 15 in 2025, putting the Allegory Project on the agenda in February for the launching of their two project boats. This February date is still tentative, pending city approval to extend the project's deadline. When complete, the boats will go on display at BYC along the marina walk way.
