Hey Members! Have A Friend?



We hope you do! Have a friend that might be interested in joining BYC, that is! Guess what! The Joining Incentives that

used to be promoted on Opening Day are available right now. And your friends are eligible to use the Club on their own from the day their membership application and one-quarter dues are received (\$258.50).

There will be *NO application fee*, a savings of \$75, and *NO initiation fee*. Furthermore, the dues they pay with their application are applied to the three months of October, November and December. They pay NOTHING additional for the summer quarter in which they apply and will not be billed until January 1, 2022!

And you, their dear friend, will receive an immediate \$50 credit to YOUR BYC ACCOUNT the day after they are voted into membership at the general meeting if your signature appears on the back of their application as their sponsor.

The Membership Committee is ready to help you with the application process ifyou have any questions (707-297-6606). Paper applications are at the top of thestairs and in the office. Or they can be printed out from the website.

Gotta Guest?

With a stream of new members coming in, and with the Club opening up more and more of its activities, it seems very timely that we review all your membership privileges in regard to guests.

- 1. **WE LOVE GUESTS!** We consider ourselves a friendly Club and we want you to bring in your friends as your guests. Guests contribute to our lunch and dinner income, the vitality of our activities, and friendly networking for our members. So feel free to invite any and all of your friends. You can have up to eight at a time under one membership (usually two members on one membership.)
- 2. **WE LOVE GUESTS WHO BECOME MEMBERS!** After all, if they enjoy coming with you and having a good time, encourage them to join. If this feels awkward, just pick up a card at the sign-in station, or refer them to the Membership Committee. You will receive a \$50 credit to your house account (unless you are a member of the Board or Membership Committee) and you will have done a solid favor to your Club in terms of helping us grow our social and financial base.
- 3. **WE PROTECT YOUR MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES.** There is a clear distinction between being a member and being a guest, even though we want all our guests to have a friendly and comfortable visit. You can help them to do that by knowing in advance what the Bylaws and House Rules say. Even though we are competitively priced, you still paid a good chunk of change for your membership and you should enjoy something for that. So the following is not meant to be unfriendly, but to protect your privileges from the possibility of others' abuse.
 - a. Guests must either <u>arrive</u> in the company of their hosts, <u>or wait</u> at the sign-in station for their hosts to escort them. No matter how often they have visited, they are not allowed to wander around the Club, or scan the crowd for someone they know in order to come in.
 - b. Hosts are responsible for <u>signing in</u> their guests with date and full names. They are also to <u>make out</u> a <u>paper name tag for each guest</u>. Because of our tax status, servers are not supposed to wait on untagged people, so please do not put our wait staff in an awkward position or jeopardize our status.
 - c. Hosts are responsible for guests' behavior.
 - d. The reason there is a <u>15% surcharge on guests' bill</u> if they pay for themselves is because some restaurant overhead is bankrolled with member funds, something that guests did not contribute to. Again, the competitively priced lunches, dinners and drinks are <u>membership privileges</u>, and are structured to be fair.

That's it! Very simple and straightforward guidelines. We hope all our members and their guests can enjoy our beautiful Club as we continue to open up from our pandemic restrictions!


