Calling All Fellow Benicia Yacht Club Owners

Members of the Benicia Yacht Club (BYC) share ownership and oversight of the Club and facilities. Mid-summer is the time to line up next year's Board of Directors and Flag Officers. Most positions are open at this point.

We are looking for interested Board candidates as well as people willing to serve on the nominating committee for 2023.

BYC bylaws specify how elections take place. A nominating committee is named by the current Board of Directors to prepare a slate of potential candidates and to interview them for the next Board. Nominations can also be made by petition. The election takes place in October, but the nominating committee must make its report by the September Board meeting so ballots can be prepared and mailed out, and so candidates' statements can make it into the October *Wind Word* newsletter.

YOU SHOULD CONSIDER RUNNING BECAUSE:

- Your opinion matters. If you leave governance of the Club to others, you risk losing a very important right that you have—the right to decide. Your opinion is as worthy as any other member's view and a variety of opinions being heard by the Board strengthens the Club.
- Ownership decisions are needed to upgrade our facilities, to keep our finances in order and generally to move the Club in a positive direction.
- The Board of Directors determines the house rules of the Club in accordance with our bylaws. Rules need review to keep them up to date.
- You provide a needed service to your fellow members.
- Being on the Board is a good opportunity to know what is going on and to get to know others in the Club better.
- You get a special name tag.

The nominating committee will be led by me according to the bylaws.
