Vessel Safety Check Day



at Benicia Yacht Club's Opening Day on the Strait Saturday, May 20, 2023 from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm


Here's an opportunity to get your vessel's safety equipment examined by a Coast Guard Auxiliary qualified examiner—FREE. There are NO fines, penalties or reports to any agency. If your vessel is properly equipped, you will be presented with the current 2023 VSC decal. Display of the decal does NOT guarantee that you will not be boarded, but should you be boarded or need equipment, you'll have peace of mind knowing you will have the correct equipment and where it is located.

The complimentary 20-minute Vessel Safety Check includes a check of: Numbering, registration or documentation, lifejackets, visual distress signals, fire extinguishers, ventilation, backfire flame arrester, horn, navigation lights, pollution and trash placards, marine sanitation device and many other important requirements. All required COVID prevention protocols will be followed. Upon completion of the Vessel Safety Check, boaters will also receive a Clean & Green Dockwalker Boating kit, courtesy of CA State Parks Division of Boating & Waterways, the CA Coastal Commission's Boating Clean and Green Program, The Bay Foundation, and USCGAUX Flotilla 5-1.

Our Adopt-a-Planter Program has successfully maintained the landscaped areas at BYC for the past five years and it is time again to re-engage our commitments. - There are 10 planter areas, 7 that are irrigated, ready for Adoption.
- Caretakers groom, weed and maintain the assigned area, but can also enhance a planter with their vision (any costs will need board approval but are reimbursable).
- Caretakers work at their availability and schedule, and determine the term of the adoption period.
- House Committee can support with tools and supplies.
- BYC will provide a sign crediting your efforts.

Rich and Angela Grigas, Susan Alton, Kathy Monroe, Kay Jaeger and Penny Trexler are just a few BYC members who have participated and supported this program in past years. Andy Zinkevich monitors and adjusts the irrigation systems, keeping the grounds appropriately

watered, while the First Saturday Clean-up Crew also jumps in with hacking and whacking, and sprinkler system repairs.

The Strait on a Rainy Saturday – Nautica Group and Frostbite Race #3

I am writing this on a rainy weekend after weeks of constant rain bringing us much needed precipitation. This would have been a good Saturday morning to stay in bed, cuddle with the wife, put a

Bogart movie on and keep an eye on the Strait through my window where it is warm, safe and dry.

Instead, January 14 started off with a meeting called the Nautica Group at the Benicia Yacht Club set up by my crew member, friend and BYC Director Randy Norman. The purpose of the group is to focus on ways that BYC can expand its water activities. We had a great turnout with some terrific input

from the attendees. I especially liked discussions about expanding programs for youth and families. The meeting was held at 9:30am so it would not interfere with the Frostbite race scheduled at noon.

You might think that the Strait does not talk, but that couldn't be further from the truth if you take time to listen. In fact, there are times when I wish she would keep her opinions to herself. Truth be told, I had no intention to participate in the race because of the weather, but as the meeting was ending a weather window opened, She was



basically telling me and the crew to come out and play, what are you a bunch of sissies? What could we do? So the crew and I decided to brave the conditions and accept the challenge.

We only had 3 boats, Warwhoop with Chuck Hooper, E Ticket with Noble Griswold, and our crew of D.J. Wood, Gary Johnson and Randy Norman on *Playpen2*. The winds were from the Southwest with a building ebb. At the skippers' meeting held at the docks we decided to go to the Joe Mara mark by Glen Cove and back, about 6 miles. We had the normal reverse start, and *Playpen2* started first, followed by Warwhoop and ending with E Ticket. Playpen2 was able to make the mark on a single tack. After we passed the mark on the return, I turned the wheel over to Randy to take us home.

Even though this was not a romp in the sun, we had a great sail. The good news, despite all the debris in the water from the storms, Randy only hit one tree—woo hoo. On top of that, the Nautica Group with Randy at the helm looks like we may be adding more dimensions to the Benicia Yacht Club, so that we can share this wonderful resource of the Strait with more activities and ideally attract families and youth to the wonders of boating.



So it looks like fair winds and following seas are in our future for 2023—all you need to do is get out of bed and let the Strait

be your guide!
