

The Board recognizes and thanks you for your all of your efforts by <u>awarding you a one-year paid membership</u>.



Back Story About Our November WIND WORD Cover

Unfortunately we were educated about the US Coast Guard Cutter *Eagle*, the ship featured on the *Wind Word*'s November cover, after the publishing date. But her history is so fascinating—we just had to share what we have learned! The *Eagle* once featured a swastika (!) and was built in Hamburg, Germany's shipyard of Blohm + Voss, who also built the *Bismarck*. She was built before the war began in 1936, as the Nazis were rapidly growing their navy. Similar to its use today, the *Eagle* was commissioned to train German sailors.

The *Eagle* wasn't used in active service until 1942, when she was deployed to the Baltics. When the

Allies liberated Europe, the British Navy seized the *Horst Wessel* (her original commission). Taken by the US as a war prize, she set sail for America in 1946 with a US Coast Guard crew—aided by the German captain and crew still on board—until she arrived in New York, and later moved to her home port of New London, CT. Ever since the end of World War II, the ship has been used to train US Coast Guard cadets to become officers. The *Eagle* enables cadets to be trained the old way—on a traditional tall ship, where they handle more than 22,000 sq ft of sail and 5 miles of rigging, building leadership and teamwork skills—and character.
