In mid-March, we temporarily closed BYC as a result of the Governor's orders about selfquarantining people aged 65 and older, sheltering in place, and, of course, the restaurant and bar aspects of our business. What goes unseen is all that our staff is doing to sanitize all surfaces that are touched—from the door knobs to the bar—throughout the BYC, using gloves, frequently washing hands, using disposable packets for condiments, etc. They are our first line of defense and they are working very hard to try to curb exposure to this virus.

Wherever we are in this situation, I pray that all of our members, staff, families and friends are faring well during this period, have taken precautions and are healthy. We are all in this together and appreciate your understanding during these trying times.

Hopefully next month's message will be a lot happier and we are well on our way to recovery.


