## MEMBERSHIP INCENTIVES EXTENDED

As you can imagine, the current shelter-in-place guidelines have put quite a damper on our April membership drive and cancelled our activities for Opening Day on the Strait. We do have some new members who are waiting for the Club to reopen in order to meet us all. As of this writing, we are hoping we might hold Opening Day in June, depending on medical assessments and state and county guidelines.

The Membership Committee has asked the Board to extend all the membership incentives listed in the April 1 *Wind Word* through the month of June, and the Board has agreed. The incentives include waiving the \$75 application fee, allowing the applicant to use the Club from the day they submit an application, and using their \$258.50 deposit to apply to the July through September quarter. In addition, any member in good standing whose name appears on the back of the application as a sponsor will receive a \$50 credit posted to their house account right after the new member is voted in at the General Membership meeting.

So if you have friends whom you would like to refer, know that you can also do this in May and June whether or not we actually hold Opening Day. We take applications any day, but on Opening Day we would like to focus on those folks who come by the Club without knowing a particular sponsor.
