The Building Project is Progressing

Things are not moving as quickly as some of us would like with the building project, but there is progress to report, and we expect that the process will start to speed up as we get past some important design issues. The purpose of this article is to keep Club members informed and ask for Club input and help.

The steering committee met twice and parts of the project are moving forward in parallel with planning and finance activities.

<u>Finance:</u> We provided a second round of responses to Umpqua Bank. We have a new CPA, due to the passing of our former one—a challenge since the bank is requesting CPA input.

<u>Planning and Design</u>: We contacted another architect to get input on the larger project and expect some recommendations in the next few weeks. So far, contacts with general contractors have not been successful. Contractors are generally very busy and short-handed and our initial needs are modest. We are continuing the search. We worked on a project vision at our last steering committee meeting. Our focus is on the priority repairs and replacements. If you have any ideas, please feel free to forward them to Andy or Richard.

<u>Work Progress</u>: Some related work outside of the main project continues. We are about to authorize work on our leaking water supply line. Plans for modifications needed to support HVAC repairs are related to selecting an architect and identifying contractors. We are now moving forward getting quotations for siding, framing repair as needed and window modifications for the East and North walls. We are also getting quotations for flooring for the whole facility. Over the next few weeks we will do some work on the deck covering with member forces.


Andy Zinkevich – Candidate for Commodore
