

ELEVATOR PITCH/SYNOPSIS

A Kind of Hush examines how life is seldom a tidy affair exploring whether there is a gray area between right and wrong. Walk in the shoes of the Mackie family enjoying a summer outing at a nearby park when tragedy strikes leaving one parent dead, their teenage daughter traumatized, and seven-year-old son found hiding in the woods. Accident or something more heinous? A mantle of ambiguity – a kind of hush – hangs between the survivors like a live grenade without its pin as each one deals with the circumstances and revelations surrounding the incident. The heart of the novel centers on how each survivor deals with the circumstances and subsequent revelations. Young Gabe's character is curious and vulnerable with an adeptness to be older and younger than his years and the others feed off his uniqueness and as he grows, so do they.

SYNOPSIS

Andee Camp inherits a box of family history after tragedy strikes along with a challenge to write a novel based on her ancestors. To fulfill this dream, she would exchange her book reviewer hat for one of a writer, forcing the seeds of self-doubt aside.
