The Faith Formation section of today's bulletin has a notice about Safe Haven Sunday, a program intended to assist married couples and families with children in their pursuit of holiness. Safe Haven Sunday is the brainchild of Covenant Eyes, an Internet accountability service endorsed by the archdiocesan Office for Life and the Family.

The 2020 Catholic Charities Appeal has begun. Money raised is directed to Catholic Social Services (including Nutritional Development Services), Catholic Special Education, Skilled Care for Retired and Sick Priests, Mission Parishes, the Office for Life and Family, Cultural Ministries, and Foundation Activities. All donated funds are deposited into a separate 501 (c) (3) account. Although our registered parishioners received a general mailing from Catholic Charities, extra forms and envelopes for the Appeal are available in the church narthex. The safety of everyone, particularly our seniors who attend Mass regularly on weekdays, is paramount.

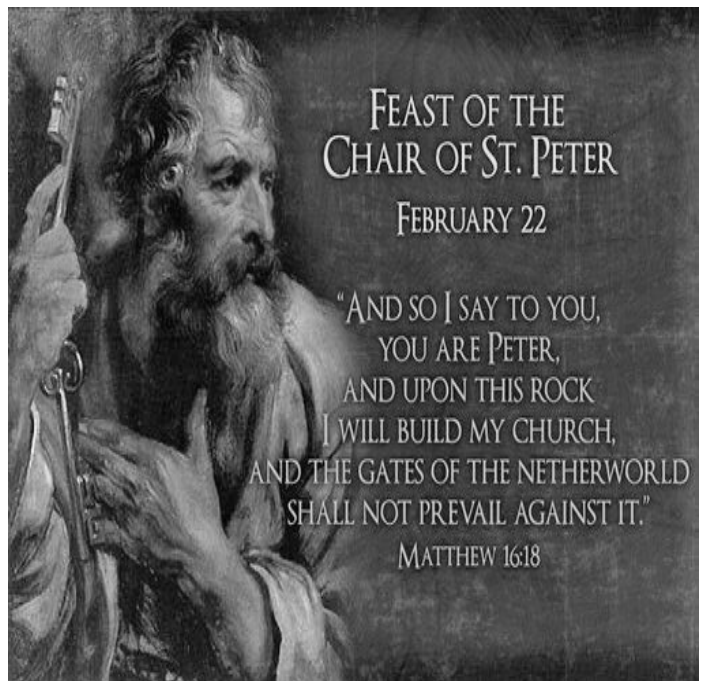


