Dear Friends,

As this is being written, it is anticipated that things will have gone well enough for us to able to have public Mass for the first time since the middle of March. It is coinciding with a time in our country that is seeing many protests turning episodes of uncontrolled destruction of property and looting. Today's Feast of the Most Holy Trinity is the first time in nearly three months that we can gather as a faith community. We pray this weekend not only for all who are victims of and affected by COVID-19, but also for a healing of wounds caused by injustice carried by so many.

Please know that even though churches are now open for public Mass, the dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on the weekend is still in effect. It is strongly suggested and recommended that people who are at high risk from catching COVID-19 remain at home. Everyone is to wear a mask while in church, except for liturgical ministers in the performance of their ministry. People living in the same house may sit together in the same pew; otherwise, you are asked to sit in a pew separate from others. Social distancing is the norm throughout the church, even while in the line to receive Holy Communion.

Because the experience of other dioceses that have reopened their churches for Mass is expected to happen within our archdiocese, it was suggested to adjust parish Mass schedules. This is the reason for no 5 PM Mass on Sunday. Also, because just 20% of the 6:30 AM Masses on weekdays from January through June (and only 13% of the 6:30 AM Masses from April through June) had Mass intentions, the only weekday Mass will be at 8 AM.

The parish office will be closed on Monday, June 8 for sanitizing. The office will reopen for business on a limited basis from 9 AM to 12 Noon beginning Tuesday, June 9. A mask will be required for anyone entering the office.

The monthly Holy Hour consisting of praying the Rosary followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Evening Prayer and Benediction is planned for Friday, June 19, the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart. All are invited to attend.

Registered parishioners not receiving regular email communications from the parish office are asked to send an email to unitedinthesacredheart@aol.com or call 610-275-1750 and leave a message.

I am grateful to all for their continued financial support of the parish during the pandemic by either mailing their contributions or brining their church envelopes directly to the rectory. A thank you is also extended to the over 45 households who are taking advantage of our online giving program. To register as an online giver, please go the parish website and click the link for Electronic Giving.

Mass intentions for the remainder of 2020 will begin to be accepted shortly. Priority will be given to intentions previously arranged to be offered on Sundays beginning the weekend of March 22.



Do you suffer from Celiac Disease?

Our parish offers a special

low-gluten host for those who join us for Mass, either during the week or for Sunday Mass. The low-gluten hosts we offer contain .01% gluten. According to the magazine, *Gluten-Free Living*, experts from the Center for Celiac Research at the University of Maryland call the host, "Perfectly safe", stating, "you would have to eat 270 wafers everyday to reach the danger point." (However, it is recommended that any Celiac suffers who wish to receive these hosts consult with their physician before usage.)

The **low-gluten** hosts we use are individually made and packaged in a wheat-free environment. They are packaged and shipped separately from any wheat products and are kept separate from other wheat products in our sacristy.

These **low-gluten** hosts meet stipulations set forth by the Roman Catholic Church and are fully endorsed by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

Anyone who may be interested in receiving Holy Communion with a low-gluten host is asked to see Leo Brady or Father Nasta before Mass.


