So many of you told me how beautiful the Mass was and how much you enjoyed yourself at the reception which followed.

Mary Breithaupt and the other musicians, along with the seminarians of St. Charles Seminary and the visiting clergy added great solemnity to the Liturgy. Leo Brady, our ever faithful sacristan, outdid himself in all the necessary preparations for such a solemn liturgy. Joe and Jeff Houseal, our faithful maintenance team, worked very hard to set up and break down all the chairs and tables in the parish hall.

Most especially, however, am I grateful to the Installation Reception Committee which was comprised of the following people: Andy and Pat Moletzsky (Chair), Melanie Moletzsky, MaryCatherine Murphy, Bernie Gutkowski and Elisa Pagnotti. 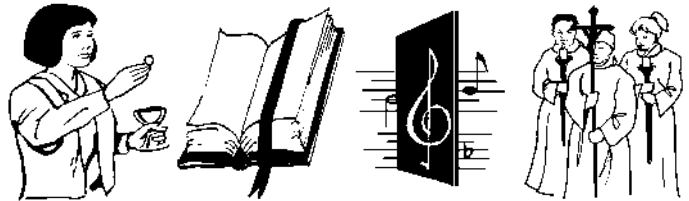
