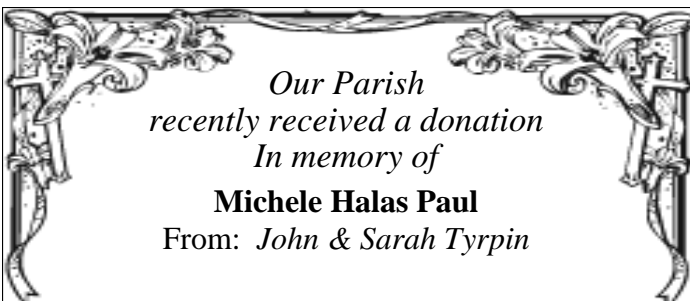

Dear Friends,

Mass intentions for the remainder of 2021 are being accepted at the parish office. Church law requires one Mass each weekend and Holyday of Obligation to be reserved for the people of the parish. Announced Masses requests are filled on a first come basis. A donation of \$10 per Mass is asked at the time of reservation. Due to the large number of requests that are made for an announced Mass to be offered either on a Saturday evening or a Sunday, it has become necessary to limit such requests to two per person.

Today's parish bulletin has an unaudited listing of ordinary parish income and expenses for the first 9 months of the current fiscal year.

Meghan Cokeley, Director of the Archdiocesan Office for the New Evangelization, is giving a presentation on the topic "Safeguarding the Dignity of Man" on Wednesday, June 16, from 7 PM to 8:30 PM at the Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul, N. 18th Street and Benjamin Franklin Parkway, Philadelphia, PA 19103. The root of *all* Church moral teaching, from abortion to immigration to sexuality, is found in a set of core, non-negotiable beliefs about what it means to be human. Ms. Cokeley will give an overview of these core beliefs and show how they form the foundation of our Catholic position on every social issue of today. This will equip us to speak more eloquently about our faith and explain to others how the Catholic position on any issue fundamentally preserves and protects the great splendor of our humanity. An indulgence is a remission before God of temporal punishment due to sins already forgiven in the Sacrament of Penance. Certain conditions and prescribed works need to be fulfilled for one to receive an indulgence. An indulgence can always be applied either to oneself or to the souls of the deceased, but cannot be applied to other persons living on earth. A person wishing to receive a plenary indulgence must:

- Be in the state of grace when the prescribed works are completed;
- Have the interior disposition of complete detachment from all sin;
- Receive Holy Communion;
- Pray for the intentions of the Pope.

The Holy See is granting a plenary indulgence to the faithful who participate in the Year of Saint Joseph (which concludes December 8, 2021) who carry out the above-mentioned conditions and participate in any of the following works:

- Meditate for at least 30 minutes on the Our Father;
- Participate in a spiritual retreat of at least one day that includes a meditation on Saint Joseph;
- Perform a corporal or spiritual work of mercy;
- Recite the Holy Rosary in families and between the husband and wife;
- Entrust their work daily to the protection of Saint Joseph and to all believers who invoke with their prayers the intercession of the worker of Nazareth;
- Pray the litany of Saint Joseph in its entirety, or some other prayer to Saint Joseph, typical of the other liturgical traditions, for the persecuted Church and for the relief of all persecuted Christians;
- Pray any lawfully approved prayer or act of piety in honor of Saint Joseph, for example "To you oh blessed Joseph," especially on the 19th day of the month or on a Wednesday.

The gift of plenary indulgence extends particularly to the elderly, the sick, the dying, all who for legitimate reasons cannot leave their home and who, with the spirit detached from any sin and with the intention of fulfilling, as soon as possible, the usual conditions, in one's own home or wherever the impediment holds a person, pray an act of piety in honor of Saint Joseph, consolation of the sick and patron of good death, confidently offering God the pains and difficulties of his life.

Next weekend will be my last here at Sacred Heart. Father Peter DiMaria will be moving in next Monday to begin his service as your pastor. Please remember us and all priests who are undergoing a change of assignments in your prayers.

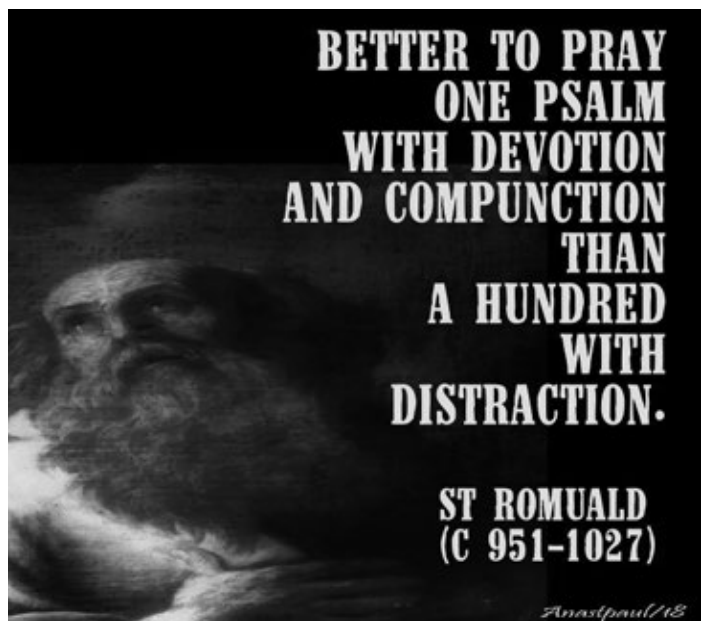
