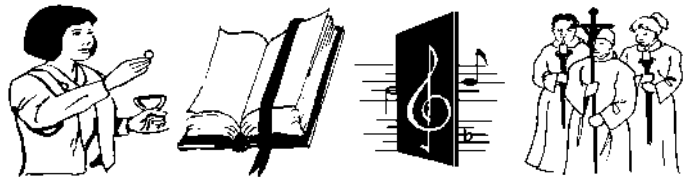

## *Faith Formation*

*Fratelli Tutti* (“Brothers All”) is the third encyclical of Pope Francis’ papacy. It was issued on October 3, 2020. Two things about it stand out from other papal encyclicals. First, Francis uses the Italian *Fratelli Tutti* on purpose to show he is quoting St. Francis of Assisi directly. Official documents from the Holy See are known usually by the first word or words of the Latin text. Second, Pope Francis refers no less than five times to a meeting he had with Grand Imam Ahmad Al-Tayyeb, who a prominent leader of the Muslim community.

*Fratelli Tutti* can be summarized in this fashion. Francis, reflecting on the way Saint Francis of Assisi carried out the divine command to Love One Another, sees that love as one that transcends boundaries and distances, and offers the church of the 21<sup>st</sup> century on how to put that love into practice. Francis hopes that *Fratelli Tutti* will invite a real fraternal love that goes beyond mere words and is put into action.

The encyclical is divided into 8 chapters with each one addressing a specific area of fraternity and social friendship.

In the first chapter, Dark Clouds over a Closed World, Francis notes the current world is marked with increased occasions of “myopic, extremist, resentful, and aggressive nationalism.” Immigration policies in parts of the world exploit xenophobia, the fear of strangers.

Border walls constructed for the purpose of preserving national interests can cause “walls in the heart” to be raised as well, which lead to a lack of appreciation and knowledge of other cultures and peoples.

Although no one will deny that migrants possess the same intrinsic human dignity as everyone else, in practice it is not the case. By the way they are treated, migrants are deemed less worthy, less important, less human. This is an unacceptable way for Christians to think and act.

Francis asks everyone to move beyond their initial fears when it comes to an influx of migrants into their locale. We must think of ourselves as a single human family dwelling in a common home.

Francis goes on to write of problems brought on by the digital age and social media. He claims the increase in networking is being accompanied by losing a sense of fraternity.

Digital communication wants to expose everything about people; our lives are under constant surveillance. The right to privacy is disappearing because digital communication allows for people to shamelessly peer into every detail of other people’s lives.

Despite the claim being made that digital relationships help build community and unites humanity, in practice they are being used to encourage an individualism that brings about xenophobia and scorn for the weak. “Things that until a few years ago could not be said by anyone without risking the loss of universal respect can now be said with impunity, and in the crudest of terms, even by some political figures.”

Everything can be created, disguised, or altered in today’s digital age and era of social communication, which allows us to select whom we wish to share our world and world view. We simply delete from our networks those with whom we disagree or deem to be unpleasant.

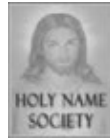
