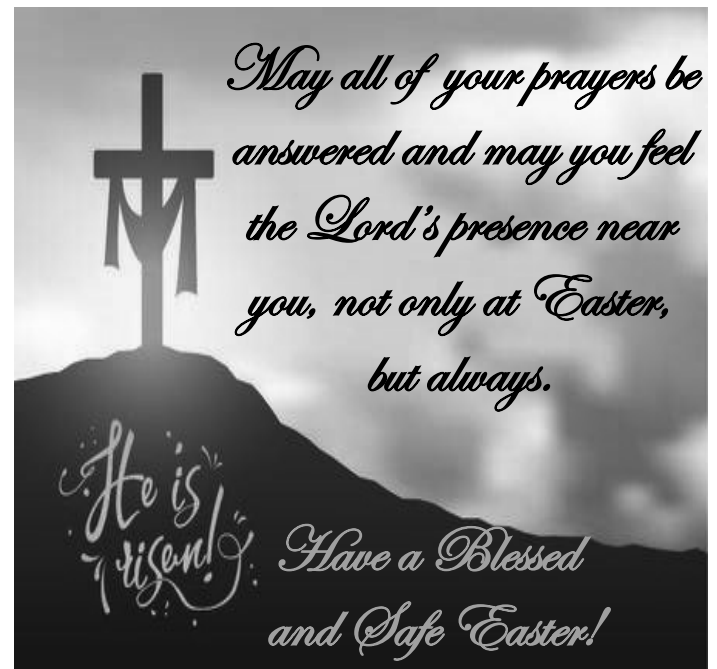

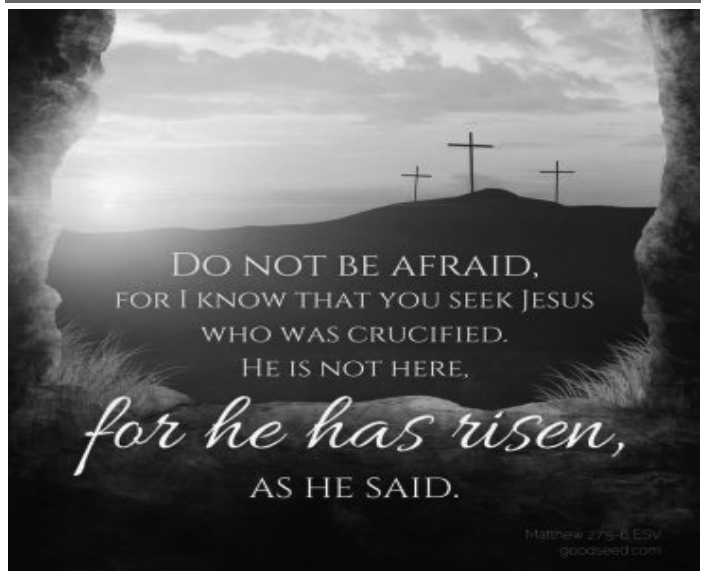

## *Faith Formation*

This is the last of a four-part summary of Pope John XXIII's encyclical on social justice, Mater et Magistra ("Mother and Teacher"), which was issued in 1961 to commemorate the 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Pope Leo XIII's landmark encyclical on this subject, Rerum Novarum ("Of New Things").

The Catholic Church's social teaching has permanent validity, John affirms, because of its foundation on one basic principle that has universal application: individual human beings are the foundation, cause, and the end of every social institution. This doctrine is to be taught in every seminary, Catholic school, and parish religious education programs; he strongly advocates every means of print and broadcast media be used to make it known. At the same time, John points out that the Church's social doctrine is not solely an academic exercise, but is to be put into practice in the lives of all. He admits, however, this presents a difficult challenge, because of peoples' attitudes of selfishness, materialism, and lack of understanding the exact demands of justice in a particular situation.

John summarizes into three words the stages one can put Catholic social teaching into practice: Look, Judge, Act. Review the concrete situation. Form a judgment on it in light of social teaching principles. Decide how the principles are to be implemented. If differences of opinion exist on how the third stage is to be carried out in a particular situation, John advocates points of agreement are to be found rather than continue endless arguments.

John then declares the Church has the right and obligation to declare her authoritative judgment in teaching ethical and religious principles as well as putting them into practice. When a decision is made by church hierarchy on an ethical or religious principle, Catholics are bound to obey the directive.

Close to the end, John offers a reflection on the Third Commandment (Remember to keep holy the Lord's Day) in light of the Church's social teaching. The Church has always demanded diligent observance of the Third Commandment for one's religious, moral, and physical well-being. The trend to ignore or reject this commandment greatly disturbs John. He pleads, in the name of God and for the sake of the spiritual and material interests of humanity, for public authorities, employers and workers, to observe the precepts of God and His Church and to remember their grave responsibilities before God and society.

Finally, the world's bishops are exhorted to earnestly reflect upon and put into practice what "Mother and Teacher" teaches. John foresees their cooperation will help to bring about the realization of Christ's Kingdom in this world. Christ, he says, must reign and triumph gloriously throughout all ages. And with the right ordering of society, John prays that all nations at last enjoy true prosperity, happiness, and peace.

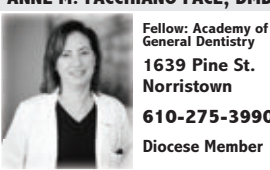
