The Central Association of the Miraculous Medal in Philadelphia's Germantown area is celebrating the Feast of Our Lady of Knock today. It is a Livestream-only event. The day begins with Mass at 1 PM followed by various presentations, starting with a virtual visit to the Shrine to Our Lady of Knock in County Mayo. A message from that shrine's rector, Father Richard Gibbons, then will be given. The event concludes with performances by County Mayo Irish Tenor Cathal Gavin, America's Any Cooney, and the Rince Ri Irish Step Dancing School and Bagpipers. The celebration can be found at [miraculousmedal.org](http://miraculousmedal.org).

A meeting for parents regarding Family Catechesis, the new approach being taken for PREP beginning this upcoming school year, is scheduled for Sunday, August 30 at 11 AM in the lower level of our parish school building. Family Catechesis is endorsed by the archdiocesan Office for Catechetical Formation. Registration forms are available at the parish office and on the parish website, [unitedinthesacredheart.com](http://unitedinthesacredheart.com). Parents are asked to fill out a registration form and send it to the parish office as soon as possible. Registration fees are \$75 for one child and \$150 for two or more children, paid by August 31. The fees increase to \$125 for one child and \$225 for two or more children on September 1.

Donations that came in the second collection for Catholic Mission Co-op came to \$1,089. This money is being sent to the archdiocesan Pontifical Mission Societies office, who in turn will send the money to the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate.

The monthly Holy Hour will be held at 7 PM on Friday, August 28, the Memorial of Saint Augustine. The Holy Hour consists of the praying of the Rosary, followed with Evening Prayer and Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. All are invited.

Registered parishioners of Sacred Heart parish are eligible to receive a 20% discount on any new pre-purchase of a grave, crypt, or niche in Saint Augustine Catholic Cemetery. Interest-free financing is available. Please call the Cemetery Office (610-272-4088) during regular business hours for more information. This offer is good throughout 2020.

The most recent update available for the annual archdiocesan Catholic Charities Appeal shows that our parish is credited with \$11,369 in donations and pledges, 67% of our \$17,000 goal. On behalf of the Appeal leadership, thank you for your generosity.

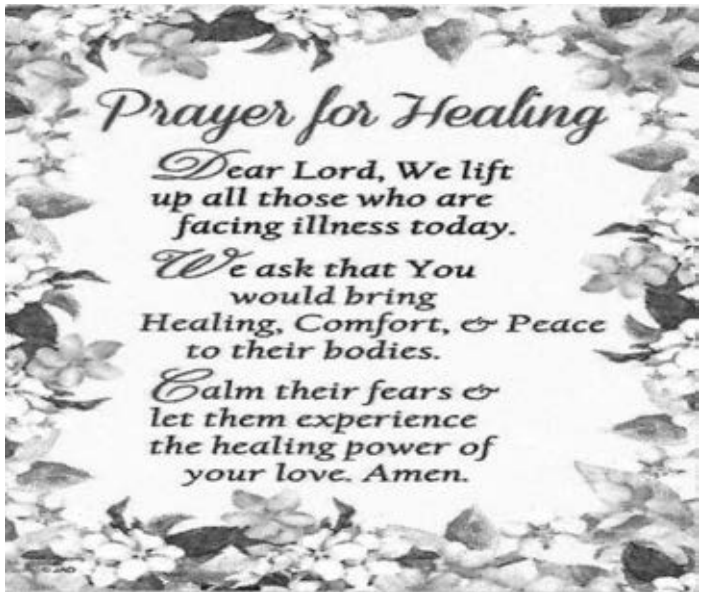

## *Faith Formation*

The Pastoral Constitution of the Church in the Modern World (*Gaudium et spes*) is the last of 16 documents from the Second Vatican Council. Promulgated by Pope Saint Paul VI on December 7, 1965 and addressed to all humanity, *Gaudium et spes* focuses on the human person itself, whole and entire, body and soul, heart and conscience, mind and will. This is the seventh of an eleven-part summary.

Through labor offered to God, the human person is united with the redemptive work of Christ. From this follows the right to work for every person. Society has a duty to help the citizens to find sufficient employment. Finally, remuneration for labor is to be such that a person and one's dependents may be given the means to nurture worthily one's own material, social, cultural and spiritual life, in view of the function and productiveness of each worker, the conditions of the workplace, and the common good.

Workers should enjoy sufficient rest and leisure to foster the growth of their family, cultural, social, and religious life. Freely founded unions should be able to represent workers, who have the right of partaking in union activities without risk of reprisal. Efforts must be made to come to a peaceful settlement when disputes occur between labor and management. If a settlement is not in the offing, a strike can be called as a last resort to defend the rights of workers and to fulfil their just desires. If this were to happen, ways to resume negotiations and discussions of reconciliation are to be sought.

Every person has the right to have a share of earthly goods sufficient for one's self and family. As a result, people are obliged to come to the relief of the poor and do so not merely out of their superfluous goods. In cases of extreme necessity, one has the right to procure for oneself what one needs from the riches of others.

More and more attempts are being made in many parts of the world to protect the rights of people to freely meet and form associations, to express one's opinion, and to profess one's religious faith both in public and in private. At the same time political systems in other parts of the world hamper civic or religious freedom, victimize large numbers through greed or political crimes, and divert the exercise of authority from the service of the common good to special interests or to rulers themselves. Political systems that do this are to be rebuked.

### Do you suffer from Celiac Disease?



Our parish offers a special **low-gluten** host for those who join us for Mass, either during the week or for Sunday Mass. The low-gluten hosts we offer contain **.01% gluten**.

According to the magazine, *Gluten-Free Living*, experts from the Center for Celiac Research at the University of Maryland call the host, "Perfectly safe", stating, "you would have to eat 270 wafers everyday to reach the danger point." (However, it is recommended that any Celiac suffers who wish to receive these hosts consult with their physician before usage.)

The **low-gluten** hosts we use are individually made and packaged in a wheat-free environment. They are packaged and shipped separately from any wheat products and are kept separate from other wheat products in our sacristy.

These **low-gluten** hosts meet stipulations set forth by the Roman Catholic Church and are fully endorsed by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

Anyone who may be interested in receiving Holy Communion with a low-gluten host is asked to see Leo Brady or Father Nasta before Mass.
