Dear Friends,

This time each year a representative from a religious congregation comes to speak about its missionary work at all the Masses. However, the many restrictions brought on by COVID-19 has caused the priest assigned to us not to come and make the appeal in-person. He has sent his talk to me and I will be making the appeal this weekend in his name.

The Pontifical Missions Societies of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia assigned the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (CMI) to Sacred Heart parish as the beneficiaries of the donations that come in for the annual Mission Co-op collection, which takes place this weekend. The Congregation of Carmelites of Mary Immaculate is the first indigenous religious congregation in the Catholic Church in India. Among its founders in 1831 is Saint Kuriakose Chavara whom Pope Francis canonized in 2014. More than 100 CMI priests serve in the United States, one of the 35 countries where they minister. All throughout the world, the CMI staff 51 Colleges and 549 Schools; 15 Hospitals, 36 Medical Centers, 46 Social Service Centers, 20 Children's Homes, and 7 Homes for the Aged; and 177 Mission Stations, 98 Parishes, and 13 Renewal Centers. They have 1,088 seminarians undergoing different stages of priestly formation. On behalf of Father Kavungal Davy, CMI, Delegate/Superior in the United States and Canada for the Congregation, thank you for your prayerful and financial support.

Thank you for the \$817 that was donated in the recent second collection for Cemetery Maintenance and the \$1,029 in last weekend's second collection for Air Conditioning.

A booklet outlining the Rules and Regulations of Saint Augustine Catholic Cemetery has been reissued. All who either have members of their family interred at the Cemetery or have made arrangements for their own interment are encouraged to pick up a copy at the Cemetery Office. More information can be found elsewhere in today's bulletin.

Also, please know that registered parishioners of Sacred Heart parish are eligible to receive a 20% discount on any new pre-purchase of a grave, crypt, or niche in Saint Augustine Catholic Cemetery. Interest-free financing is available. Please call the Cemetery Office (610-272-4088) during regular business hours for more information. This offer is good throughout 2020.

The Office for Life and Family announces a new ministry within the archdiocese, the Saint Raymond Nonnatus Foundation for Freedom, Family, and Faith. The Foundation is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization whose mission is to assist individuals, children and families impacted, affected, or wounded by divorce and help them sustain (or reconcile) their redemptive relationship with Jesus Christ and His Holy Church. It provides spiritual direction, helpful resources, retreats, and events. The Foundation holds a podcast on the first Tuesday of each month from 8 PM to 9 PM for Catholics affected by Divorce and Separation. Another podcast is held on the last Thursday of the month from 8 PM to 9 PM for Families in Crisis. The podcasts are available on YouTube, Facebook, and the Tune-In app. The Foundation does not offer housing or financial, legal, medical, or psychological counseling. For more information about the Foundation, please either go to their website, [Nonnatus.org](http://Nonnatus.org), or text or call 215-870-9913. Saint Raymond Nonnatus is the patron saint of Christian families, expectant mothers, pre-born babies, and those falsely accused.

Registration is open for our parish's Family Catechesis, the new approach being taken for PREP beginning the upcoming school year. Parents are asked to fill out a registration form and send it to the parish office as soon as possible. Registration fees are \$75 for one child and \$150 for two or more children, paid by August 31. The fees increase to \$125 for one child and \$225 for two or more children on September 1. Family Catechesis is endorsed by the archdiocesan Office for Catechetical Formation. 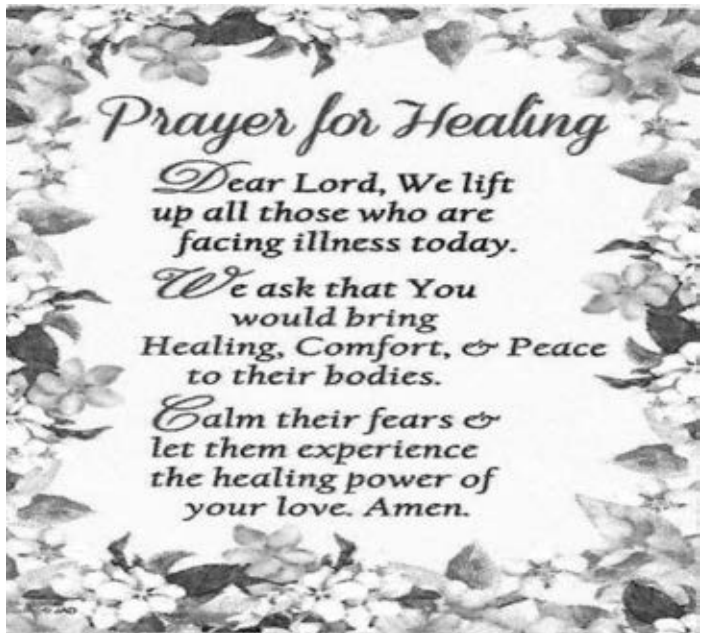

Dear Friends,

In addition to caring for the spiritual well-being of Catholics in this area of the archdiocese, Sacred Heart Parish has the responsibility for the care of Saint Augustine Catholic Cemetery at 175 W. DeKalb Pike in King of Prussia. The Cemetery is not merely the final resting place of the faithful departed, it is a sacred place where people come to pray for their departed loved ones, that the perpetual Light of Christ may shine upon them. The Cemetery is consecrated ground.

In order to maintain and preserve its dignity and sanctity, Saint Augustine Catholic Cemetery has a newly reissued set of Rules and Regulations. These Rules and Regulations are based primarily from the ones issued by the former Cemeteries Office of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. Rules and Regulations from other area parish cemeteries were also used as a guide.

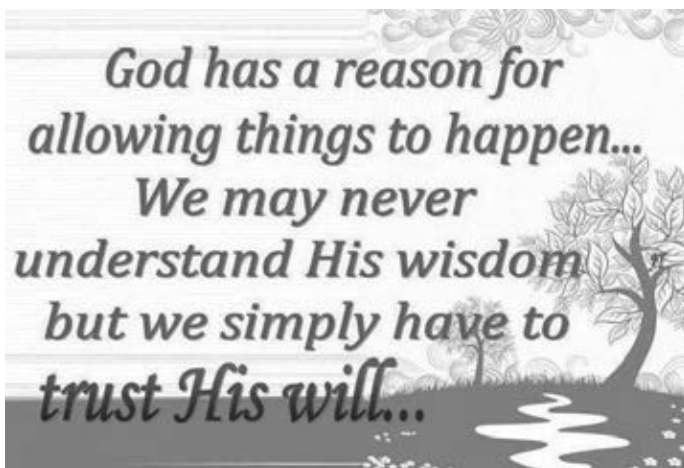
Certificate Holders of a Lot and family members of those interred at the Cemetery are encouraged to go to the Cemetery Office and pick up a copy of the Rules and Regulations. It would be also an opportunity at that time for Certificate Holders and family members to verify their contact information with the Cemetery Office. The Cemetery Office is open Monday through Thursday from 9 AM to 3 PM and from 9 AM to 12 Noon on Friday.

A motivation behind the reissuance of the entire set of Rules and Regulations is that the current set is not being observed as it ought. For example, the sign posted at the Cemetery Entrance states that glass containers, vigil lights and artificial decorations are not permitted. However, it is not uncommon to see such items throughout the cemetery. Other memorials or mementos, generally of a secular nature, are also becoming commonplace.

The newly reissued Rules and Regulations for Saint Augustine Catholic Cemetery become effective on November 2, 2020, the Solemnity of the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed. This gives plenty of time for everyone to obtain a copy of the Rules and Regulations, read them, and help do their part in ensuring that the entire Cemetery will continue to be a place of dignity, respect and reverence now and for generations to come.
