Dear Friends,

In the spirit of *Laudato Si*, his encyclical on the environment, Pope Francis instituted a World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation to be celebrated each year on September 1. This observation is intended, in the words of the Holy Father, to “reaffirm [our] personal vocation to be stewards of creation, to thank God for the wonderful handiwork which he has entrusted to our care, and to implore his help for the protection of creation as well as his pardon for the sins committed against the world in which we live.” A prayer composed for this occasion by the pope is printed elsewhere in today’s bulletin.

A meeting for parents regarding Family Catechesis, the new approach being taken for PREP beginning the 2020-2021 school year, is scheduled for today, August 30 at 11 AM. Family Catechesis is endorsed by the archdiocesan Office for Catechetical Formation. Registration forms are available at the parish office and on the parish website, unitedinthesacredheart.com. Parents are asked to fill out a registration form and send it to the parish office as soon as possible. Registration fees are \$75 for one child and \$150 for two or more children if paid by September 20. The fees increase after that date to \$125 for one child and \$225 for two or more children.

The Saint Raymond Nonnatus Foundation for Freedom, Family, and Faith is having its monthly podcast for Catholics affected by Divorce and Separation this Thursday and every first Thursday of the month from 8 PM to 9 PM. The podcast is available on YouTube, Facebook, and the Tune-In app. The Foundation’s mission is to assist individuals, children and families impacted, affected, or wounded by divorce and help them sustain their redemptive relationship with Jesus Christ and his Holy Church. The Foundation is endorsed by the archdiocesan Office for Life and Family. More information about the Foundation can be found on their website, Nonnatus.org, or by texting or calling 215-870-9913. Saint Raymond Nonnatus is the patron saint of Christian families, expectant mothers, pre-born babies, and those falsely accused.

The collection for the Solemnity of the Assumption was \$1,156 and the collection for Catholic University came to \$496. Thank you for your generosity.

The next monthly Holy Hour will be held at 7 PM on Tuesday, September 15, the Memorial of Our Mother of Sorrows. The Holy Hour consists of the praying of the Rosary, followed with Evening Prayer and Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. All are invited.

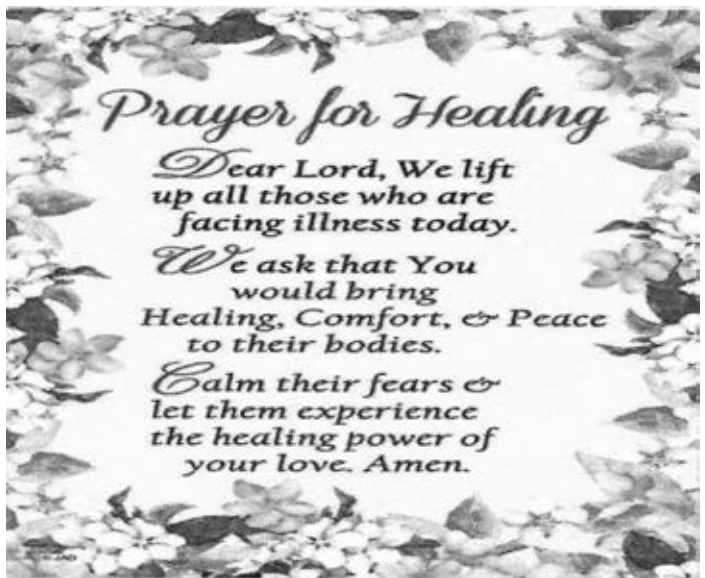
