Dear Friends,

Advent is a time for us to reflect on our relationship with the Lord and to prepare ourselves more thoroughly for his coming again in glory. Seeking God's mercy through the Sacrament of Penance is a prime means for us to encounter and experience his reconciling love. In addition to the usual times for Confessions on Saturday afternoons, Confessions will also be heard on Saturday, December 19 at 11 AM; and Wednesday, December 23 at 1 PM and 7 PM.

Because government leaders have imposed seating capacity restraints on churches due to the coronavirus, Archbishop Pérez has granted permission this year for priests to offer additional Masses for Christmas and, in case of necessity, for a parish to have a Christmas Eve Mass as early as 2 PM. **Therefore, our Mass schedule for Christmas Eve this year is: 2 PM, 4 PM, 8 PM, 10 PM, and 12 Midnight. Masses will also be offered on Christmas Day at 8 AM and 10:15 AM.** It is hoped that having seven (7) Masses between Christmas Eve and Christmas Day will allow for sufficient social distancing for all to feel safe when coming to church for the celebration of the Birth of Our Lord.

The 4 PM Mass on Christmas Eve has historically been the Mass with the highest attendance. To avoid an overcrowding situation at this Mass, I encourage people to consider coming to either the 2 PM or 8 PM Mass, where attendance is expected to be lighter. **There will not be an extra 4 PM Mass in the school cafeteria as in previous years.** Also, to allow more room in the pews for social distancing, I encourage people accustomed to attending Midnight Mass to consider attending the 8 PM or 10 PM Masses. Thank you for your understanding.

Visitation B.V.M. Church, 196 N. Trooper Road, Norristown, PA 19403, is having "Follow the Star," a Drive-Thru Live Nativity Scene (with live animals) on Friday, December 18, from 7 PM to 9 PM. You can drive past three stations (Annunciation, Visitation, Nativity) while the parish choirs sing songs you can hear on your car radio. It is a free family event, although donations will be accepted. To register for a timeslot or for more information, please either visit visitationbvm.org or call 610-539-5572.

Faith Formation

Last Tuesday was the 45th anniversary of the promulgation of *Evangelii nuntiandi* (*To Proclaim the Gospel*), Pope Saint Paul VI's Apostolic Exhortation on evangelization. The document was released one year after the 1974 Synod of Bishops on evangelization. Pope Francis once called *To Proclaim the Gospel* the "greatest pastoral text ever written." This is the second of a series of articles summarizing Pope Saint Paul's teaching.

Evangelization is the Church's deepest identity. The Church exist to evangelize, to preach and teach the Gospel, to be the means through which God's grace is bestowed to humanity, to reconcile sinners with God, and to perpetuate Christ's sacrifice in the Mass. There is a profound link between Christ, the Church, and evangelization.

Even though the Gospel and Evangelization can borrow from the elements of human culture or cultures, neither is identical with culture and both are independent from all cultures. Every effort must be made to evangelize cultures.

The only true Evangelization that takes place is the one that proclaims the name, teaching, life, promises, kingdom and mystery of Jesus of Nazareth, the Son of God. The kerygma (preaching or catechesis) is an important aspect of evangelization, but is only one aspect of it. Kerygma reaches full development when it is heard, accepted, integrated into one's life, and genuinely lived each day. The person who is evangelized goes on to evangelize others.

Paul points out these secondary elements of evangelization: bearing witness to Christ, proclaiming that salvation is offered to all as God's gift, and salvation that goes beyond the limits of this world to a life that is fulfilled in eternity. Therefore, evangelization must include a proclamation of the hereafter, the preaching of hope in the promises offered by Christ, God's love for all, of our love for each other, of self-denial, and of the search for God Himself through prayer. In its totality, evangelization consists of the implantation of the Church.

Evangelization is complete when it takes into account the unceasing interplay of the Gospel and one's lived life, both personal and social.

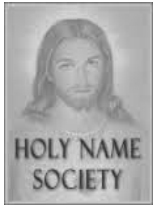
GAUDEAMUS Music Ministry
