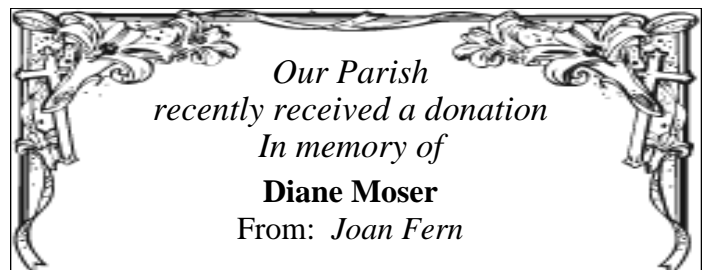

Dear Friends,

The second collection this weekend is the annual appeal for the Retirement Fund for Religious. Many religious communities in the United States do not have enough retirement savings and are struggling to provide for their aging members. COVID-19 has only increased these challenges. Thank you in advance for your generosity to this Appeal.

Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary's annual Christmas Concert is a live-stream event this year due to the coronavirus. The Concert, featuring the seminary choir and musicians, will take place today, December 6, beginning at 2 PM. The Concert can be viewed through the seminary's website, scs.edu.

Thank you for your generosity in the second collection last weekend for Christmas Flowers which came to \$1,165.

The Parish Office will be closed on the Fridays of December. In addition, both the Parish and Saint Augustine Catholic Cemetery Offices will be closed Monday and Tuesday, December 7 and 8.

Tuesday, December 8 is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Patroness of the United States of America. Masses for the holyday will be at 7 PM on Monday, December 7 and at 6:30 AM and 9 AM on Tuesday, December 8.

The next Holy Hour takes place at 7 PM on Friday, December 11 and will be in honor of Our Lady of Loreto. The monthly Holy Hour consists of the praying of the Rosary, Evening Prayer, and Exposition and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament. All are invited.

Holy Family Council No. 3327 of the Knights of Columbus is offering scholarships valued up to \$3,000 to deserving students who are from Sacred Heart, St. John the Baptist, or SS. Peter and Paul parishes and plan to be enrolled at an archdiocesan Catholic grade or high school in our area or a Catholic college or university for the 2021-2022 academic year. Applications for the scholarships are available at the parish office during regular business hours. Applications must be postmarked by January 4, 2021.

Thank you for your continued financial support of the parish. Remember when writing a check, the only things to be written in the box provided are the numerals (and decimal point) of your donation in dollars and cents. The scanner misread at least 8 checks last week because some added "\$," "xx/100," "no/100," or wrote the dollar amount only. Also, please use either blue or black ink when writing your check and don't forget to sign it.

Parishioners are invited to contact the parish office if they are aware of a fellow parish family facing unemployment and has need of a meal for Christmas.

In the event inclement weather causes Upper Merion Area School District to either delay the start of the school day or close the schools, morning Mass will be cancelled and the intentions for those Masses will be transferred to the next available day. The safety of everyone, particularly our seniors who attend Mass regularly on weekdays, is paramount.

Flags placed by the gravesites of deceased veterans interred at Saint Augustine Catholic Cemetery are being removed. Flags worn or tattered will be properly disposed. Family members of deceased veterans interred or entombed at the cemetery who wish a flag are asked to contact the cemetery office during regular business hours. New flags will be placed by Memorial Day 2021.

Advent is a time for us to reflect on our relationship with the Lord and to prepare ourselves more thoroughly for his coming again in glory. Seeking God's mercy and through the Sacrament of Penance is a prime means for us to encounter and experience his reconciling love. In addition to the usual times for Confessions on Saturday afternoons, Confessions will also be heard on Thursday, December 10 at 7 PM; Saturday, December 19 at 11 AM; and Wednesday, December 23 at 1 PM and 7 PM.

Please feel free to take a 2021 calendar home with you after Mass. Also, booklets from the Diocese of Saginaw with spiritual reflections for Advent are available in the back of church.

## Faith Formation

Tuesday, December 8, 2020 marks the 45<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the promulgation of Evangelii nuntiandi (To Proclaim the Gospel), Pope Saint Paul VI's Apostolic Exhortation on evangelization. The document was released one year after the 1974 Synod of Bishops on evangelization. Pope Francis once called To Proclaim the Gospel the "greatest pastoral text ever written," so it is good for us to examine what it says and why our Holy Father holds it in high regard. What follows is the first of a series of articles summarizing Pope Saint Paul's teaching.

Paul sets the tone in one of the opening paragraphs by going to the heart of evangelization and its purpose. "[T]he presentation of the Gospel message is not an optional contribution for the Church. It is the duty incumbent on her by the command of the Lord Jesus, so that people can believe and be saved. This message is indeed necessary. It is unique. It cannot be replaced. It does not permit either indifference, syncretism, or accommodation. It is a question of people's salvation."

He goes on to synthesize a few essential aspects of evangelization. Everything else is relative when compared with the Kingdom of God. Salvation is God's gift that liberates one from everything that oppresses humanity, above all, sin and the Evil One. It must be patiently carried on during the course of history.

Kingdom and Salvation are key words of Jesus' evangelization. They are available to humanity as grace and mercy, yet at the same time, are gained through toil and suffering, a Gospel-centered life, and self-denial and bearing the cross. Above all this, a person gains the Kingdom and Salvation through metanoia, a profound change of heart, a total conversion of one's self to Christ and the Gospel.
