Dear Friends,

Today is World Marriage Day. In recognition of this special day, I have prepared a summary of information regarding the celebration of marriage in the church. This summary can be found in the Faith Formation section of today's parish bulletin.

The rectory and cemetery offices will be closed Monday, February 15, for the Presidents' Day holiday.

Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the season of Lent. Ashes will be distributed during the 8:00 AM Mass as well as during Liturgical services at 12:15 PM and 7:00 PM. So that there is no physical contact, this year ashes will be sprinkled upon the top of a person's head rather than be imposed on the forehead. No one is under any obligation to receive ashes; however, we are obliged on Ash Wednesday and all the days of Lent to heed the call of the Gospel to reform our lives by carrying out the traditional works of penance - prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The schedule of Devotions and Faith Formation events during Lent was in last week's bulletin. The traditional rules on fast and abstinence are in today' bulletin.

Stations of the Cross will be prayed at 7 PM on Friday, February 19.

The next parish Holy Hour will begin at 7 PM on Tuesday, February 23, the Commemoration of Saint Polycarp. The Holy Hour consists of praying the Rosary followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Evening Prayer, and Benediction. All are invited.

In the event inclement weather causes Upper Merion Area School District to either delay the start of the school day or close the schools, morning Masses will be cancelled and the intentions for those Masses will be transferred to the next available day. The safety of everyone, particularly our seniors who attend Mass regularly on weekdays, is paramount.

Also, just a reminder that registered parishioners of Sacred Heart parish are eligible to receive a 30% discount on any new pre-purchase of a crypt in Saint Augustine Catholic Cemetery. Interest-free financing is available. Please call the cemetery office (610-272-4088) during regular business hours for more information. This offer is good throughout 2021.

World Marriage Day

Today is World Marriage Day. Included below is a summary of some practical information regarding the celebration of the Sacrament of Marriage in the Catholic Church.

- A Catholic is bound by church law to be married within a Catholic church in the presence of two witnesses and a priest (or deacon) using the approved ritual. This is known as the *Form of Marriage*. A Catholic who is married according to the Form of Marriage does so validly and licitly. A valid and licit marriage ends with the death of one of the spouses.
- Both the bride and the groom must be free to marry. Sworn statements to support this fact may need to be obtained. If either or both has/have been previously married, a declaration of nullity from the (arch)diocesan tribunal needs to be obtained before a wedding date can be set. A death certificate is required in cases where a previous marriage ended with the death of a spouse.
- A couple intending to marry must inform the parish priest at least six (6) months prior to the wedding date for adequate preparations.
- The parish church of either the bride or the groom is the locale for a marriage ceremony. Permission needs to be obtained for the ceremony to occur in another parish church.
- Priests (and deacons) validly and licitly officiate at marriage ceremonies in the parish to which they are assigned by their (arch)bishop. A priest (or deacon) assigned elsewhere needs to obtain delegation from the pastor or parochial vicar assigned to the parish where the marriage is to take place. If this priest (or deacon) lives and works in another (arch)diocese, he also must obtain a letter from his (arch)diocesan official or religious superior stating he is a priest (or deacon) in good standing within his (arch)diocese or religious community.
- Deacons are permitted to officiate at marriage ceremonies taking place in the parish church but only if the celebration takes place outside of Mass. If there is a Nuptial Mass, the priest celebrating the Mass is the officiant.
- Permissions can be granted by the local bishop for marriages between a Catholic and a non-Catholic. The Catholic signs a statement affirming his/her Catholic faith with the promise that children born from the marriage will be baptized and raised as Catholics. The non-Catholic is made aware of this promise.
- A dispensation from the Form of Marriage (see above) can be granted in the case of a Catholic and non-Catholic wishing to exchange marriage vows in the church of the non-Catholic.
- The Archdiocese of Philadelphia does not grant a dispensation from the Form of Marriage for a marriage ceremony of two Catholics to take place at a location other than a Catholic church, including a location outdoors.
