A summary of the parish ordinary income and expenses for the first nine months of the most recently concluded fiscal year is in today's bulletin.

Father Joseph Zingaro, pastor of Sacred Heart Church from 1993 to 2000, died on May 20. Next Sunday's 10:15 AM Mass will be for the happy repose of his soul.

Saint Augustine Catholic Cemetery, like all cemeteries, depends upon a regular source of income to meet its current expenses. The main sources of regular income for cemetery operations are the fees charged for purchases of burial lots and grave openings. Many years in the future the cemetery will have no more burials or interments, yet the grounds will still need to be cared for. For this reason, St. Augustine Catholic Cemetery, and all cemeteries, charges a one-time fee for Perpetual Care at the time a grave is purchased. Perpetual Care money is kept in a separate account and can only be used after the cemetery has its final burial or interment. The second collection envelope for Cemetery Maintenance dated for July 19 is intended to help offset our current day to day cemetery operations. Thank you for your understanding.

The monthly Holy Hour for our parish's Rosary Society and Holy Name Society will be held at 7 PM on Thursday, July 16. Prayers will be offered that evening in honor of Our Lady of Mount Carmel.

Parents of our grade school children recently received a mailing from John Horn, our Coordinator of Religious Education, regarding a new approach for PREP beginning this fall. Family Catechesis is a program endorsed by the archdiocesan Office for Catechetical Formation. Family Catechesis combines home schooling and monthly meetings at church with the use of a formal syllabus. A registration form accompanied the introduction letter. Extra registration forms are available in the rear of the church.
