Dear Friends,

The Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ today. Some general reminders about the proper reception of Holy Communion can be found elsewhere in the bulletin.

The Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary recently announced their new mission appointments. Sister Dolores Joseph, IHM, will be taking up residence at Sacred Heart convent while ministering to the sick of St. Patrick Parish, Norristown. All the other sisters who live in the parish convent will continue to do so. Sister Dolores Joseph will be moving into the convent probably by the beginning of August.

The monthly Holy Hour consisting of praying the Rosary followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Evening Prayer and Benediction is planned for Friday, June 19, the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart. All are invited to attend. The Holy Hour begins at 7 PM.

Archbishop Pérez will ordain 5 men priests for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia this Saturday, June 20, at the Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul. Although the ceremony is not open to the public due to the pandemic, it can be viewed at either <https://vimeo.com/424979675> or on the Facebook page of Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary.

Mass intentions for the remainder of 2020 are now being accepted at the parish office. Church law requires one Mass each weekend and Holyday of Obligation to be reserved for the people of the parish. Announced Masses requests are filled on a first come basis. A donation of \$10 per Mass is asked at the time of reservation. Due to the large number of requests that are made for an announced Mass to be offered either on a Saturday evening or a Sunday, it has become necessary to limit such requests to two per person.

The Priest Personnel Manual of the archdiocese states that in addition to his vacation and annual retreat, a priest is entitled to one day off each week, including an overnight. It is understood that some adjustment to the pastoral schedule may need to be made so the priest's need for a day off can be accommodated. Because of this, requests for an 8 AM Mass on days when I know I am away either for vacation, fulfilling responsibilities as National Chaplain for the First Catholic Slovak Union, or a day off (usually Thursdays) will be put on hold unless there is a change in my schedule. The parish reserves the right to transfer a weekday Mass intention to another day if circumstances warrant. Thank you for your understanding

Registered parishioners not receiving regular email communications from the parish office are asked to send an email to unitedinthesacredheart@aol.com or call 610-275-1750 and leave a message.

Those who attended Mass last weekend most likely noticed that another set of the church's stained glass windows were removed. The windows are being inspected for signs of warping and then will be cleaned and reset. The outdoor wooden frames will be stripped of paint, inspected for signs of damage, replaced as needed, and repainted. Like what was done with other windows that underwent restoration, new protective glass able to withstand ultraviolet rays from sunlight will be installed over the windows. Since only a couple of windows will be worked on at a time, it will take a few years for this project to be completed.

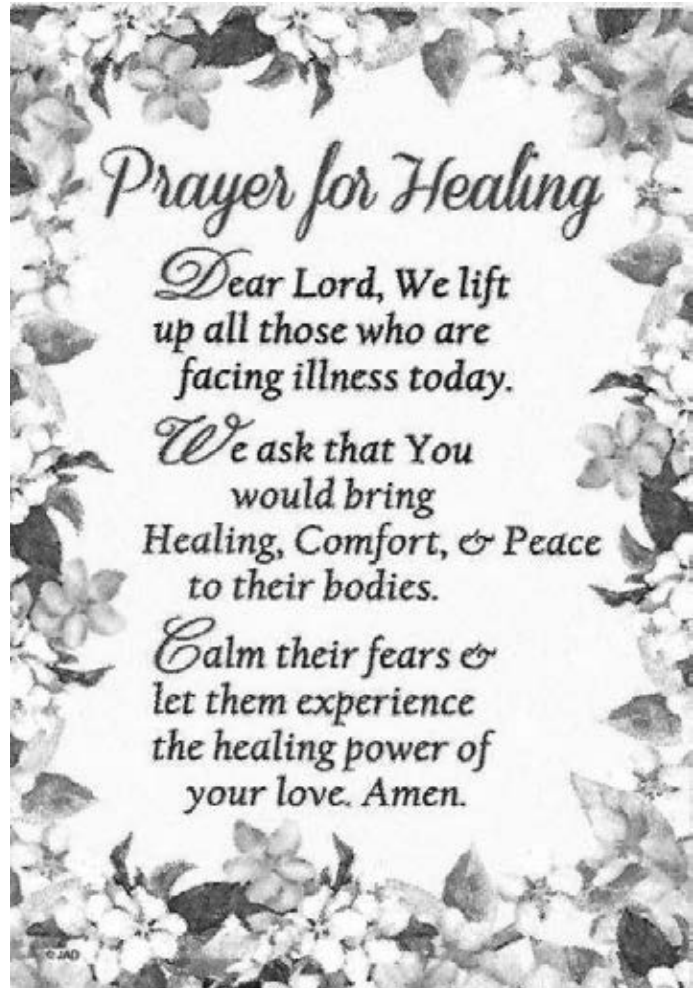

The church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ this weekend. Listed below are some general reminders regarding the reception of Holy Communion:

- Only members of the Catholic faith are permitted to receive Holy Communion in the Catholic Church. Non-Catholics are not permitted to receive Holy Communion in the Catholic Church, nor are Catholics permitted to receive Holy Communion in another faith community.
- Catholics who are aware of having committed a mortal sin are to receive the Sacrament of Penance prior to receiving the Eucharist.
- Catholics whose marriage did not take place according to the laws of the Church or are living with another as if they are married are to refrain from receiving Holy Communion until the situation can be resolved.
- Catholics may receive Holy Communion a second time in a day, but only if that second time takes place during a Mass they attend.
- Catholics are to refrain from eating or drinking one hour prior to receiving Holy Communion. Water never breaks the fast. It is inappropriate to chew gum while in church, especially before receiving Holy Communion.
- Catholics are to make a bow of the head or another gesture of reverence immediately prior to receiving Holy Communion.
- The only proper response to "The Body of Christ" is "Amen."
- Catholics wishing to receive Holy Communion in the hand are to bring both hands before the priest, deacon or extraordinary minister and place one hand directly under the other with palms faced up. It is inappropriate to have one's hands form a 'V' or to offer only one hand with the palm up while keeping the other hand at one's side.
- It is inappropriate to use one's thumb and forefinger to take the host from the minister. The minister places the Sacred Host on the open palm
- Catholics who wish to receive Holy Communion in the hand are to make sure their hands are clean.
- Catholics who receive Holy Communion in the hand are to consume the host immediately.
- Catholics in the Communion Procession are to approach the minister close enough so the minister is not forced to overextend his or her reach.
- People not receiving Holy Communion at Mass are to remain in the pew and not participate in the Communion Procession.
