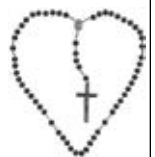

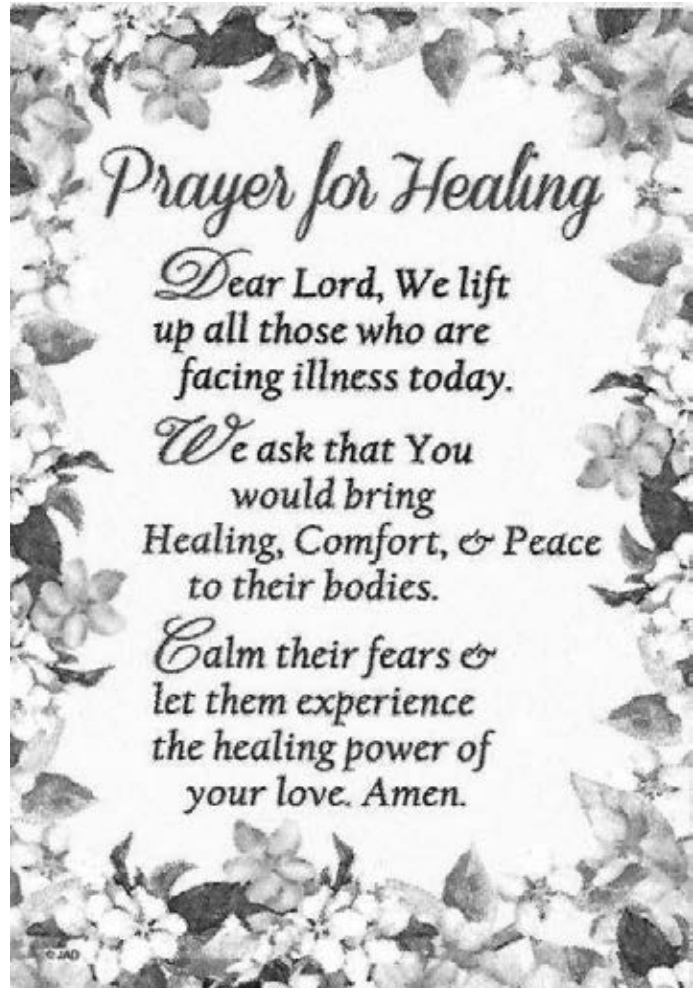

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As missionary disciples of Christ in our day, we are called to be genuinely concerned for the well-being of our brothers and sisters who lack the basic necessities which everyone deserves in order to live a full and dignified human life.

## RELIGIOUS FREEDOM WEEK

Religious Freedom Week takes place each year between June 22, the Memorial of Saints Thomas More and John Fisher, and June 29, the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. What follows is adapted from the website of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

### Sunday, June 28 – Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Central African Republic

**Pray** that God would show the people of the Central African Republic (CAR) the way to peace and reconciliation.

**Reflect:** The CAR is one of the poorest countries in the world. Nearly 60% of its 4.9 million people depend on humanitarian assistance. In 2012 a coalition of rebel groups from the predominantly Muslim North launched a rebellion that deposed the CAR's president. Non-Muslim rural communities strengthened traditional self-defense militias. The conflict that started primarily over political power and access to natural resources now resorts to banditry and attacks on unarmed Muslim and Christian civilians, making religious identity a driving force. Religious leaders continue the hard work of healing the trauma of war and rebuilding a new society.


**Act:** The Partnership between Catholic Relief Services (CRS) religious leaders in the CAR supports trauma healing programs, peacebuilding practices, and other programs. The Church also provides humanitarian aid to thousands of wounded and displaced victims. Consider participating in this work by donating to CRS.

### Monday, June 29 – Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul Civility


**Pray** that God would give us the grace to remember the dignity of all and invite others to do the same.

**Reflect:** The strong tradition of the Catholic Church's social teaching compels us to be actively engaged in the building up of our communities. This is achieved by being involved in the political process. And yet today many shy away from such involvement because our national and local conversations are filled with vitriol and harsh language. What is needed is good, honest, civil dialogue. It means treating everyone as our neighbor.
