Dear Friends,

We welcome Most Reverend Michael Fitzgerald to Sacred Heart Church today. Bishop Fitzgerald is here to confirm 7 of our young parishioners at today's 10:15 AM Mass. Congratulations to our children receiving this sacrament by which they complete their initiation into the Church and to their families.

Pope Francis announced that 2021 is a year to be dedicated to Saint Joseph. To commemorate this observance, we will be having two liturgical celebrations on his feast day, Friday, March 19. Morning Mass at 8 AM will include the praying of Morning Prayer. That evening at 7 PM there will be a Holy Hour consisting of devotional prayers to Saint Joseph, Evening Prayer, and Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. The Holy Hour will take the place of Stations of the Cross. All are invited.

A novena prayer for the Year of Saint Joseph is in today's parish bulletin. We will be offering this prayer before our Sunday Masses beginning the weekend of March 20-21.

The next regular parish Holy Hour will take place at 7 PM on Thursday, March 25, the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord. All are invited to join in praying the Rosary, followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Evening Prayer and Benediction.

Last weekend's second collection for the Church in Africa was \$894. Thank you for your generosity.

A letter dated February 12, 2021 from the Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary Appeal was recently received. The letter gives an update on the Appeal's progress. Through January 21, 2021, 57 gifts have been received from Sacred Heart Parish amounting to \$4,274. By comparison, the 2019-2020 Appeal received \$3,955 from 60 Sacred Heart donors. Father James Lyons, former parochial administrator of Saint Augustine Church, is hosting a pilgrimage to Italy with the Passion Play of Oberammergau. Departure is May 31, 2022 from Philadelphia International Airport. The tour includes stops in Munich, Innsbruck, Venice, Florence, Assisi, and Rome. Return to Philadelphia is June 10, 2022. Price is \$4,736 per person, double occupancy and includes round trip airfare, accommodations, taxes, service charges, and most meals. Anyone interested is asked to contact me for a brochure.

A few 8 AM weekday Masses between now and the end of June remain available for specific intentions. Requests for unannounced Mass intentions, those offered on an unspecified day and/or location, are also being accepted. It is preferred that all requests for Mass intentions, both announced and unannounced, be made in person at the parish office during regular business hours. A donation of \$10 per Mass is requested. All Mass Intentions for Saturday evening or Sunday have been reserved until the end of June. Mass Intentions for July through December will begin to be accepted near the end of May.

The Office for Persons with Disabilities and the Office for Ministry with Young Adults is hosting a virtual workshop from 10:00 AM to 11:30 AM on Saturday, March 20 called Ministry of Belonging. The workshop is intended to foster an authentic connection between young adults with and without intellectual disabilities. During the sacred season of Lent, bring me closer to you.

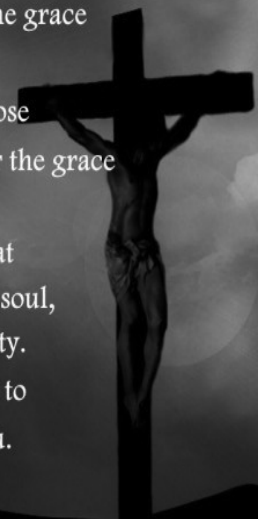
Prepare a place in my home and heart for silence and solitude, so that I may re-discover the grace of a prayer-full life.
