Dear Friends,

November is the month dedicated to the remembrance of the faithful departed in prayer. The names of your beloved deceased family and friends that are written on the All Souls envelopes are located at a place of honor near the altar. Your beloved deceased will be remembered at all Masses during November. Last weekend's bulletin presented the archdiocesan guidelines regarding the proper use of "words of remembrance" at a Funeral Mass. Elsewhere in today's bulletin is a summary of the church's norms for cremation.

From forming our future priests and deacons, to educating hundreds of lay men and women pursuing degrees in religious education, the influence of Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary is far-reaching. Please consider supporting our seminary by making your gift to the Annual Appeal. **All donations and pledges to the Appeal are to be put in the envelope that came in your direct mailing from the Foundation and sent directly to the Seminary. Extra pledge/donation cards are available in the pamphlet rack in the church narthex.** Thank you for your understanding and support of the Annual Saint Charles Seminary Appeal.

The holyday collection for the All Saints amounted to \$1,185 and the money received in the All Souls envelopes was \$1,588. Thank you for your generosity.

The next monthly Holy Hour will take place on Wednesday, November 18, the Optional Memorial of Saint Rose Philippine Duchesne, the "woman who prays always." The Holy Hour will include Exposition and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament and begins at 7 PM. Everyone is invited.

As you most likely have notice, the Office for Divine Worship for the archdiocese has granted permission for missalettes to be returned to the pews and holy water to be put in the font. The holy water is changed regularly.

Parents of our PREP students are reminded of the session in church at 7 PM on Thursday, November 19. I will conduct a prayer service for them that includes Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

Requests for announced Mass intentions for the first six months of 2020 will be accepted after Thanksgiving. Requests for unannounced Mass intentions are always accepted. Unannounced Mass intentions are those that are offered on an unspecified day and/or location. These Mass intentions are frequently sent to priests who do not have the opportunity to offer daily Mass on a regular basis in a parish. Examples are priests who are assigned to work full time in Catholic high schools, colleges and seminaries; chaplains to nursing homes, hospitals, and religious communities; priests who work in the foreign missions; and priests in retirement.

The list of birthdays is intended for everyone in our parish community to pray for our fellow parishioners celebrating their special day. Please contact the parish office during regular business hours if you wish either to have your birthday omitted from the weekly listing or in case of a correction.

The Archdiocese of Philadelphia is hiring teachers with a proficiency in Business, English, Fine Arts, Health, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Special Education, Theology, and World Language. Administrators representing archdiocesan schools and the Office of Catholic Education will be available to interview interested candidates and answer any questions. An Educator Career Fair is being conducted Monday, November 9, 2020 from 10 AM to 1 PM. It is a virtual event. Candidates should possess at least a bachelor's degree; Pennsylvania Certification is desired. ## Guidelines for Cremation

The Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, under the authority and with the approval of Pope Francis, issued an instruction in October 2016 entitled "To Rise with Christ." The instruction attempts to clarify questions people may have about cremation and offer a set of directives.

The primary principle that runs through "To Rise with Christ" is the never changing Church teaching that human remains are always to be given and shown proper respect and dignity. Directives for cremation in "To Rise with Christ" closely mirror those given from the archdiocese a few years ago. In summary, the guidelines are:

- The Church prefers the ancient practice of burying the bodies of the deceased.
- If the decision is made for the deceased to be cremated, the Church prefers the Order of Christian Funerals be celebrated in the presence of the body of the deceased, and then have the body taken for cremation.
- It is permitted for an urn containing the ashes to be brought into Catholic church for a Funeral Mass. The urn is placed on a table in front of the sanctuary, without the display of photos or other mementos. A white pall is not placed on the urn.
- Ashes of the deceased are to be buried in a cemetery or laid to rest in a columbarium within thirty days after the body is cremated.
- Ashes of the deceased are forbidden to be:
  - \* Scattered in the air, on land, or at sea
  - \* Preserved in mementos, pieces of jewelry, or in other objects
  - \* Reserved in a home
  - \* Reserved in a home while awaiting another person (usually a spouse) to die so both can be buried together at the same time
  - \* Divided among family, friends, or others
  - \* Commingled with the ashes of another person or pet.

*Born in Grenoble, France, in 1769, Rose joined the Society of the Sacred Heart. In 1818 Rose was sent to the United States. She founded a boarding school for daughters of pioneers near St. Louis, the free school west of the Missouri, and a school for Indians. She was known for her courage in facing frontier conditions, her singlemindedness in pursuing her dream of serving Native Americans, and her self-acceptance. This holy servant of God was beatified by Pope Pius XII in 1940 and canonized by Pope John Paul II in 1988.*



## Do you suffer from Celiac Disease?

Our parish offers a special **low-gluten** host for those who join us for Mass, either during the week or for Sunday Mass. The low-gluten hosts we offer contain **.01% gluten**. According to the magazine, *Gluten-Free Living*, experts from the Center for Celiac Research at the University of Maryland call the host, "Perfectly safe", stating, "you would have to eat 270 wafers everyday to reach the danger point." (However, it is recommended that any Celiac suffers who wish to receive these hosts consult with their physician before usage.)

The **low-gluten** hosts we use are individually made and packaged in a wheat-free environment. They are packaged and shipped separately from any wheat products and are kept separate from other wheat products in our sacristy.

These **low-gluten** hosts meet stipulations set forth by the Roman Catholic Church and are fully endorsed by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.
