Dear Friends,

November 3 is Election Day. It is our civic duty to participate in our democracy and to choose people to represent us in government. Certain advocacy groups may attempt to distribute campaign literature or voter guides on our church property and parking lot. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), the Pennsylvania Catholic Conference (PCC) and the Archdiocese of Philadelphia have strict guidelines as to what literature may or may not be made available and distributed on church property. Approved voting guides were made available in October and can be obtained by going online to either archphila.org or catholic.philly.com. Please know that any other literature you may find distributed in the parish parking lot or anywhere else on parish property was done without the permission, consent, or approval of the archdiocese and me as your pastor.

Our parish's annual period of Eucharistic Adoration, also known as the Forty Hours Devotion, will begin after today's 10:15 AM Mass and will conclude on Tuesday, October 27. Since it is important for at least one person to be in church while the Most Blessed Sacrament is exposed on the altar, you are encouraged to indicate the half-hour you will be able to be present before the Eucharistic Lord by signing a paper in the rear of the church. Sunday's period of adoration will end at 5 PM with a prayer service and Benediction. Evening Prayer and Benediction at 7 PM will conclude Monday's adoration. Forty Hours will end on Tuesday with a prayer service and Benediction beginning at 7 PM.

Last weekend's second collection for World Mission Sunday was \$616. Thank you for your generosity.

A list of parishioners' birthdays for the upcoming week will be included in the parish bulletin, beginning in November. Please contact the rectory if you do not wish your name and birthday to be included in the listing.

Today's bulletin has a summary of the unaudited report of the parish's Ordinary Income and Expenses for Fiscal Year 2020. Many thanks to the members of our Parish Finance Council (Joseph Houseal, Larry Kilian, Richard Kuras, and Angelo Pagnotti) as well as Ed Scott, our Parish Business Manager, for assisting me with caring for the temporal goods of the parish. The following is meant to assist you in reading the statement:

- Other Parish Collections include the Christmas, Easter, and Holyday collections, second collections for parish use, and memorial donations and offerings from baptisms, weddings, and funerals.
- Stole Fees are donations received from baptisms and funerals.
- Rentals, Net include rental income from the school building and housing allowance received for the sisters in the convent.
- Diocesan Assessment is used by the archdiocese to subsidize most archdiocesan ministries as well as pay the regular operating expenses and employee salaries of those working in the Archdiocesan Pastoral Center.
- Pastoral Administration includes costs of Wi-Fi, telephone, postage, and expenses that do not fit into the other categories.
- Outside Printing includes the cost of printing and mailing of our church collection envelopes.
- Liturgical Supplies include the costs for flowers and other church decorations, candles, hosts and wine, palms, music, and the missalettes.
- Maintenance of Property includes costs associated with annual maintenance contracts, trash removal, lawn care and snow removal, and routine maintenance to the roofs, plumbing, and HVAC units.

Monsignor George Majoros, former parochial vicar here at Sacred Heart, was appointed by Pope Francis to be the Missionary of Mercy for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. All Missionaries of Mercy, including Monsignor Majoros, are granted permission by the Holy Father to absolve sins that are reserved to the Holy See for forgiveness. Examples of these sins are the desecration of the Blessed Sacrament and the recording of what is said during a Confession, whether real or simulated, and/or disclosing what was said on social media. Monsignor is available for Confession on the first Sunday of each month at 5:30 PM at the Cathedral Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul, 18th Street and Benjamin Franklin Parkway, Philadelphia, PA 19103.
