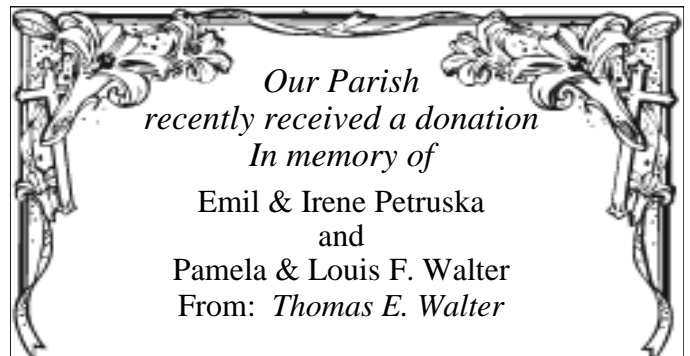

Dear Friends,

Today is Catechetical Sunday. This observance in Catholic churches throughout the country is an opportunity for parishes to recognize in a special way those who participate in the teaching ministry of the church. Many thanks to John Horn, our Coordinator of Religious Education, and our catechists, Michelle Efthimiadou, Barbara JanFrancesco, Joan Koeck, Linda Moser, and Brenda Turner for sharing their time and talent in assisting the parents of our children with their formal instruction in the faith.

The archdiocese sent out a communication asking for parishes to conduct a second collection to assist those affected by the wildfires in California, Oregon and Washington, and Hurricane Laura that devastated parts of Louisiana. We will take the second collection at the Masses the weekend of October 10-11.

Thank you for your donations last weekend to the Saints Cyril and Methodius Appeal. The collection came to \$410 and the money will be used to support the residence for priests from Slovakia sent to Rome by their bishops for graduate studies, the Pontifical College of Saints Cyril and Methodius.

Three young members of our parish will be receiving their First Holy Communion at next Sunday's 10:15 AM Mass.

In addition to the prayers that are offered to end abortion and to protect human life, prayers are also offered during the weekly Holy Hour on Wednesdays for priests and an increase of vocations to the priesthood. All are invited to come on Wednesdays at 12:00 noon and pray for these and all intentions.

National Night Out is an annual community-building campaign that promotes police-community partnerships and neighborhood camaraderie to make our neighborhoods safer places to live. It provides a great opportunity to bring police and neighbors together under positive circumstances. National Night Out usually is marked on the first Tuesday of August, but because of the Coronavirus, it is rescheduled for Tuesday, October 6. Members of the Upper Merion Township Police Department will be going to 6 different locations throughout the township beginning at 4 PM, giving them time to get out and have some fun with the community. The parking lot at our church will be the last stop of the tour. The anticipated arrival time will be between 6:30 PM and 7:00 PM.

The Saint Raymond Nonnatus Foundation for Freedom, Family, and Faith is having its monthly podcast for families in crisis this and every last Thursday of the month from 8 PM to 9 PM. The podcast is available on YouTube, Facebook, and the Tune-In app. The Foundation's mission is to assist individuals, children and families impacted, affected, or wounded by divorce and help them sustain their redemptive relationship with Jesus Christ and his Holy Church. The Foundation is endorsed by the archdiocesan Office for Life and Family. More information about the Foundation can be found on their website, Nonnatus.org, or by texting or calling 215-870-9913. 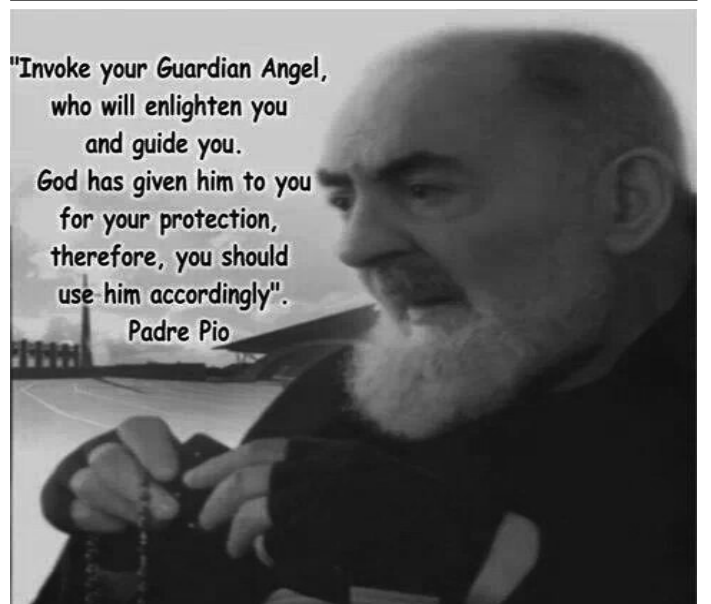

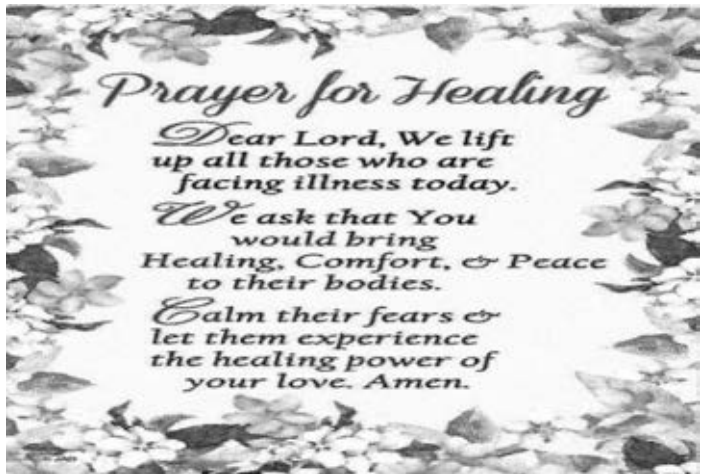

Faith Formation

The Pastoral Constitution of the Church in the Modern World (*Gaudium et spes*) is the last of 16 documents from the Second Vatican Council. Promulgated by Pope Saint Paul VI on December 7, 1965 and addressed to all humanity, *Gaudium et spes* focuses on the human person itself, whole and entire, body and soul, heart and conscience, mind and will. This is the tenth of an eleven-part summary.

The presence of nuclear weapons (called “scientific weapons” here) and the possibility of a nuclear war obligated the bishops to evaluate the concept of war with a new and different attitude. The use of nuclear weapons goes far beyond the bounds of legitimate defense because of the massive and indiscriminate destruction they cause. An almost total and reciprocal slaughter on each side would happen if the great nations use their nuclear armories to the fullest in war, not to mention the deadly after effects these weapons cause. Previous condemnations of total war made by recent popes are confirmed. In addition, any act of war aimed at the indiscriminate destruction of extensive areas and their population is a crime against God and humanity that merits definitive and outright condemnation.

The Constitution disagrees with the assertion some nations were making that manufacturing and stockpiling nuclear weapons is a deterrent to war and an effective way to maintain peace between nations. It teaches, rather, the accumulation of nuclear arms gradually increases the potential for war. Humanity should be convinced that neither the arms race nor the so-called balance of power resulting from this race brings about and preserves a sure and lasting peace. The arms race is described as a treacherous trap for humanity, one that shackles the poor to an abhorrent degree. While enormous amounts of money are spent developing newer weapons, satisfactory remedies to the many miseries afflicting the poor are left behind.

The day is yearned when all nations mutually agree to outlaw all war. Meanwhile, prayerful support should be given to all who work to eliminate war, so that they may persevere in their efforts to build peace. Working for international peace can be successful only when feelings of aggression, scorn, and mistrust as well as racial hatred and uncompromising ideologies that continue to divide the human race are eliminated. The Church does not cease to hope most firmly for the conversion of the human heart.

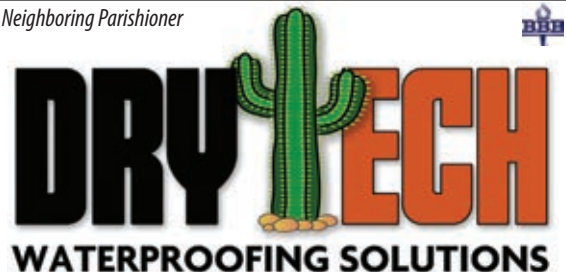
