

The pipeline fields combines the main gas Turkmenistan, located in the east of the country, with the western regions and the Caspian Sea and has created a closed gas transmission system in Turkmenistan. The pipeline allows for the transit of significant volumes of gas both east and west.





The capacity of the gas pipeline is 30 billion cubic meters per year, the length is 733 km. The diameter of the gas pipes is 1420 millimeters. The pipeline originates at the Shatlyk gas compressor station the Mary region Turkmenistan and crosses the territory of Mary and Akhal regions to the west. It then leads the Belek to gas compressor station in the Balkan region.
