Meeting Minutes

The Fairwood Crime Prevention and Improvement District (“District”) held a meeting at Fairwood Branch Library, Thursday, January 20, 2022.

The meeting was called to order by Chair, Scott Giurintano at 6:30 p.m.

No members of the public were in attendance.

Scott Giurintano and Lloyd Gavion, Jr. were sworn in by attorney Sheri Morris for four-year terms.

Approval of minutes

Motion was made by Joanne Cowgill and seconded by Lloyd Gavion to accept minutes from the December 16, 2021, meeting.

The motion passed unanimously.

Treasury Report

Expenditures for the past month totaled \$7,050.85. This included payments for the lawn service, security patrol, and two new Flock cameras. Income for the past month was \$27,501.98. The current balance is \$27,618.86.

Motion to approve the report was made by Pat Cormier and seconded by Scott Giurintano.

The motion passed unanimously.

Flock Security Cameras.

Between December 19, 2021, and January 20, 2022, there were 118,680 license plates read. The highest daily reading was Friday, December 23, 2021, with 5,332 plates read.

No arrests were reported. There were four hits on the hot list including two stolen vehicles and two stolen plates.

Two additional Flock cameras have been ordered and will be installed at the intersections of Millerville and Spring Ridge and at Millerville and Deer Ridge. The CPID is responsible for payment for permits which will be ordered by Flock.

Security Patrols

In December, there were 24 hours of security patrol. The time was spread over eight days, all during evening hours. During that time, citations were written for 12 stop sign violations.

Security Incidents in the District

Pat Cormier reported that on December 29, 2021, there was a report of three individuals walking through neighborhoods pulling on car doors. There were reports of item stolen from some vehicles. There also was a report of a lawn mower stolen from a garage.

Neighborhood Watch Committee

There was no report.

Several attempts have been made to contact the website administrator via email. Pat Cormier will attempt to contact the administrator in person.
