Meeting Minutes

The Fairwood Crime Prevention and Improvement District ("District") held a meeting at Fairwood Branch Library, Thursday, February 17, 2022.

Approval of minutes

Motion was made by Pat Cormier and seconded by Lloyd Gavion to accept minutes from the January 20, 2021, meeting.

The motion passed unanimously.

Treasury Report

Expenditures for the past month totaled \$1,515.00. This included payments for the lawn service and security patrol. Income for the past month was \$1829.43. The current balance is \$27,933.29.

Melanie Sims prepared and had notarized the CPID sworn financial statement for 2021. It has been submitted to the Louisiana Legislative Auditor.

Motion to approve the report was made by Scott Giurintano and seconded by Pat Cormier.

The motion passed unanimously.

Flock Security Cameras,

Between January 16 and February 17, 2022, there were 129,450 license plates read. The highest daily reading was Friday, February 11, 2022, with 4,974 plates read.

No arrests were reported. There were 16 hits on the hot list.

Installment of the two new cameras at the intersections of Millerville and Spring Ridge and at Millerville and Deer Ridge is pending completion of the permitting process.

Security Patrols

In January, there were 24 hours of security patrol. The time was spread over nine days, with times ranging from 2:00 pm to 1:00 am, and shifts ranged from two to 4.5 hours. During that time, citations were written for 12 stop sign violations.

Security Incidents in the District

Pat Cormier reported that there were no incidents from the website due to the website being down during January 2022.

There was a report from Lt. Cody Grace of an incident in which he got a Hot List Hit on his phone from our camera near Old Hammond Hwy. as he was ending his two-hour patrol shift at 4:30 pm on February 2, 2022. He responded as did a Baton Rouge Police unit. After a search, they did not find the vehicle.

There was no report.
