Meeting Minutes

The Fairwood Crime Prevention and Improvement District (“District”) held a meeting at Fairwood Branch Library, Thursday, May 19, 2022.

The meeting was called to order by Chair, Scott Giurintano at 6:36 p.m.

Approval of minutes

Motion was made by Pat Cormier and seconded by Lloyd Gavion to accept minutes from the April 21, 2022, meeting.

The motion passed unanimously.

Treasury Report

Expenditures for the past month totaled \$1,515. This included payments for lawn service and security patrol. Income for the past month was \$135.96 for parcel fees. The current balance is \$23,927.67.

Motion to approve the report was made by Scott Giurintano and seconded by Pat Cormier.

The motion passed unanimously.

Flock Security Cameras

Between April 19 and May 19, 2022, there were 181,602 license plates read. The highest daily reading was 8380 on Friday, May 13, 2022.

There were 23 users of the system – 15 by the EBR Sheriff's Office and 8 by the Baton Rouge Police.

No arrests were reported. There were 31 hits on the hot list.

Installment of the two new cameras is still pending completion of the permitting process. An address has been obtained for each of the permits.

Security Patrols

In April, there were 24 hours of security patrol. The time was spread over seven days, with times ranging from 2:00 pm to 2:30 am. During that time, citations were written for 11 stop sign violations.

Security Incidents in the District

Pat Cormier reported a total of 9 calls for assistance between April 1 and April 30, 2022. This included three calls for alarms activated, one 911 hang up, one crash with injuries, one disturbance, one domestic battery, one improper telephone communication, and one suspicious incident/person/vehicle.

Neighborhood Watch Committee

Thomas Shuff reported the following:

- A neighborhood Watch Meeting will be held on June 16, 2022. The topic has not been decided.
- One resident volunteered to serve as a block captain. However, more block captains are still needed.

Insurance Renewal

A notice has been received regarding insurance renewal for this year.
