Meeting Minutes

The Fairwood Crime Prevention and Improvement District (“District”) held a meeting at Fairwood Branch Library, Wednesday, December 4, 2019.

The meeting was called to order by Chair, Scott Giurintano at 6:31 p.m.

Approval of Minutes

Motion was made by Pat Cormier and seconded by Melanie Sims to accept minutes from the August 14, 2019 meeting.

The motion passed unanimously.

New Business

Canvass Election Results

Attorney Sheri Morris explained the canvass of votes process. Scott Giurintano read the votes. There was a total of 393 votes cast in favor of the proposition and a total of 168 votes cast against the proposition. It was declared in open and public session that the Proposition to create the Fairwood Crime Prevention and Improvement District passed by a majority vote in the election held on Saturday, November 16, 2019.

Pat Cormier moved and seconded by Scott Giurintano to accept the election returns. The motion passed unanimously.

Proposal to make the Fairwood Crime Prevention and Improvement District a “No Solicitation” District

There was discussion to make the District a “No Solicitation” District. Attorney Morris said each Homeowners Association would have to vote to make the District a “No Solicitation” District.

A motion was made by Scott Giurintano and seconded by Pat Cormier to recommend that each HOA vote to become a “No Solicitation” District.

The motion passed unanimously.

Each HOA would have to pay for the “No Solicitation” signs.
