cannot even count how many times I have had workers and employees tell me of their struggle to hire young adults when it comes to skilled labor. The pool of skilled labor workers has sharply declined over the past decade among the younger generations.



Unfortunately, many of our youth today have no idea of the career possibilities available to them; they are frequently told in school that they must obtain a four- or six-year degree to be successful in life. Yet, this could not be further from the truth. In fact, while the average college student graduates with approximately \$30,000 in debt, only forty percent of those can find full-time jobs upon graduation. It so often happens that they get stuck working at a near minimum-wage job they would have been able to land without any kind of degree.

Do not mistakenly think, however, that I do not believe in much of the training offered by four-year institutions and graduate schools; quite the contrary, I think there are a number of important professions that rightly require such degrees and licensures. My point is that many of our youth

assume they need such advanced degrees and often enter into programs they do not even enjoy. Indeed, many of them would prefer to work in a trade field where they can use their hands and develop their creative ingenuity.

The good news, however, is there are so many opportunities available to youth today as skilled laborers, the demand for whom are at unprecedented levels. It is estimated that there are one-half million more jobs in trade disciplines such as

construction, manufacturing, and aviation than there are workers. And this number is expected to rise to 2 million within the next five years. These are occupations which only require two-year degrees or apprenticeship programs, and yet they offer well-above average pay.

I was recently talking with an employer in construction whose company was so desperate for workers that they were willing to train anyone in from scratch, with pay and full benefits, and with an above-average salary! My father, who is a machinist, told me that his company will take anyone with a two-year machinist degree, pay for their schooling, and give them full benefits with a starting salary of over \$50,000 per year! And these opportunities are not unique – they are everywhere today.

To assist our youth of today in discovering and preparing for such careers, G.A.L.S. Technology has, over the past few years, put together high-quality internship programs for both high school students and adults. G.A.L.S. Technology offers extensive training programs in the areas of screen-printing, embroidery, graphic arts, and business administration. We also have a new Build-A-Business program which gives our youth the skills and direction needed to become entrepreneurs who are able to start a business of their own (more information about the Build-A-Business program can be found on PAGE 4).
