

## The Foulis Medal at Leith Links - Friday 8 July 2022

The Foulis Medal was presented to Leith Rules Golf Society in 2007 by the Society's first President Douglas Foulis. It is competed for annually by Leith based organisations playing two rounds (10 holes) medal play over Leith Links in foursomes format. No handicaps are involved.

This year the competition was played on the evening of Friday 8 July with seven teams competing. In comparison to the previous year the weather was dry and fine but was accompanied by a stiff breeze.
